## SERVITE DOMINUM IN TIMORE

Beginning a new calendar year is always a time to take stock of the blessings past and set our sights on the hopes that the new year brings. In a spiritual way, our life of virtue should follow the same course: standing firm on our unchanging foundation while aiming toward new blessings and new progress in holiness during the year ahead.

Inspired by last year's Year of the Eucharist, I can't resist continuing to share with you the insights of the Church Fathers regarding the Blessed Sacrament. In my last column, I featured the writings of St. John Chrysostom. Today I continue with this teaching of his which tells us to trust God's revelation more than our own bodily senses. He writes, "Let His WORD be of superior authority to reason and sight. This too [should] be our practice in respect to the [Eucharistic] Mysteries, not looking only upon what is laid out before

us, but taking heed also of His Words. For His Word cannot deceive; but our senses are easily cheated. His Word never failed; our senses err most of the time. When the Word says, "This is my body," be convinced of it and believe it, and look at it with the eyes of the mind. For Christ did not give us something tangible, but even in His tangible things all is intellectual....How many now say, "I wish I could see His shape, His appearance, His garments, His sandals." Only look! You see Him! You touch Him! You eat Him!"

We rely on our senses for earthly survival, but yet, our spiritual survival requires more. With St. John to guide us, may our spiritual senses be formed by the most-reliable Word of God and open our vision to the presence of God with us!
