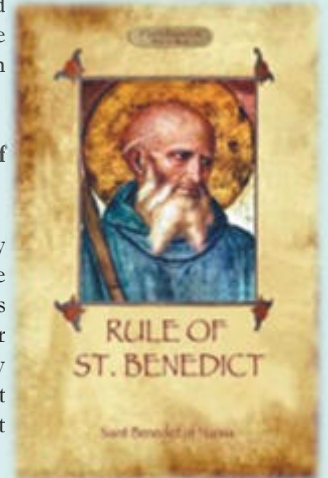
FAMILY FUNDAMENTALS

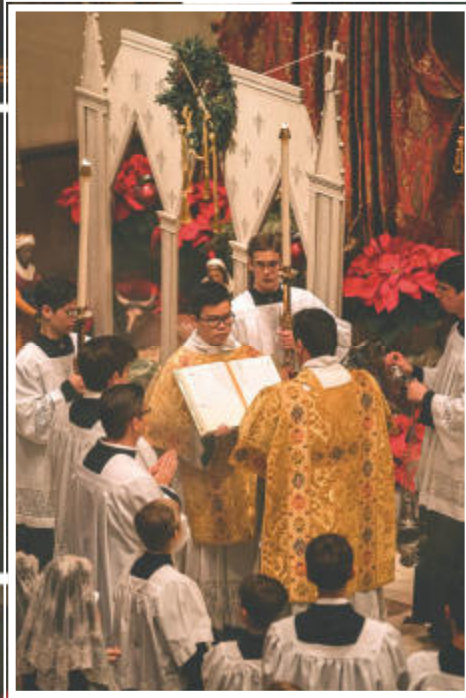
