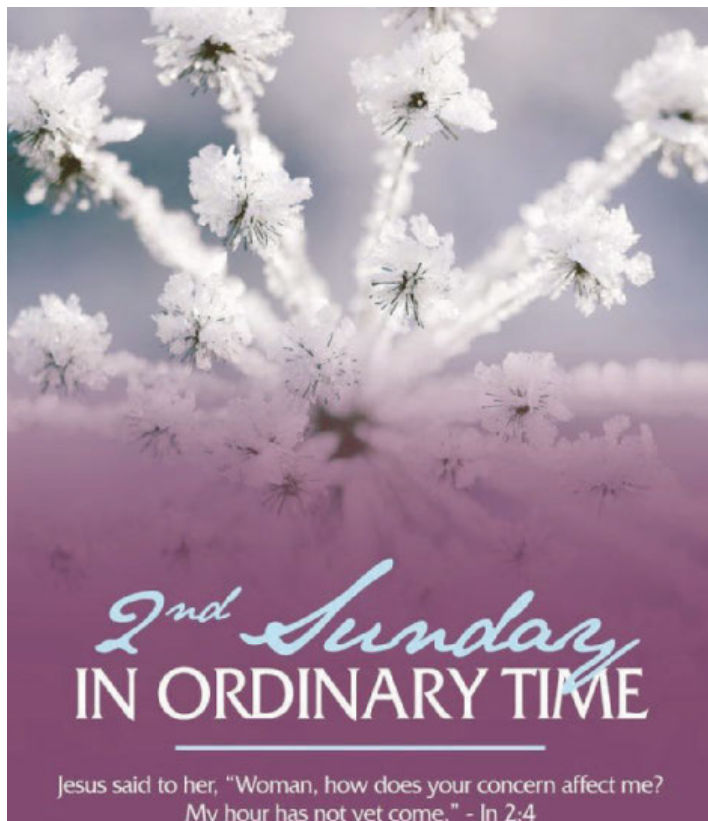

A Message from our Pastor—Father John Jerek

Dear parishioners,

As we make our way through a new year, we continue to struggle against this almost two-year old pandemic. In many ways we recognize that we are part of a “new normal” which affects almost all areas of our lives, including church. Our councils and committees have discussed our ministries and programs, recognizing that we are not yet “out of the woods.” Much thought and prayer has gone into our discussions.

In light of this, I encourage everyone to wear masks during worship and at parish activities when possible. Our use of the parish center should include no more than 150 people in the entire space to respect appropriate social distancing. I also strongly discourage reception of Holy Communion on the tongue. While we have not separated pews throughout the church, I ask that you use common sense in maintaining a healthy distance between you and your families and others.

Parish Council and the Parish Family Life Committee have spent much time discussing the parish festival and we believe it is time for some major changes to this once annual event. As we go forward, our festival will be known as the St. Christine Annual Feast Day Celebration and Reunion, with its date as close as possible to our parish patronal feast on July 24. Thus this year’s festival will be the weekend of July 23 and 24, Saturday 5 pm to 10 pm and Sunday 1 pm to 8 pm. We will not be offering amusement rides and commercial food vendors will be at a minimum. The amount of gambling will also be reduced to make this event more family-friendly and we will pitch this as our parish’s annual reunion, inviting many alumni and family members beyond the parish to join us for worship and for the weekend’s celebration. We will include our annual money raffle, basket raffle, bake sale, homemade foods and dinners. While details have not been finalized, we look forward to much planning and participation in the coming months. Please plan on volunteering and helping in some way.

Our Parish and Family Life Committee will be sponsoring a “Winter Feast” on Saturday, February 12 which will feature an upscale candlelight dinner including soup, shrimp Louis salad, steak Diane, potatoes and dessert for \$30.00 person. Only 125 tickets will be sold. Details will follow next weekend.
