### LITURGICAL NOTES

Entrance: Remember, O Lord, your covenant, and do not abandon for ever the souls of your poor; arise, O Lord, and judge your own cause; forget not the cries of those who seek you.

Offertory: In you have I put my trust, O Lord; I said: "You are my

God, my destiny is in your hands."

**Communion:** The bread which I will give is my flesh for the life of the world.

God longs to give us life in abundance ("The bread which I will give..."), for He created us for Himself, to experience intimacy with Him – Father, Son, and Holy Spirit – for all eternity. The degree to which we trust in His mercy is the degree to which we shall receive His blessing. And even when our trust is small, His mercy and blessings far outweigh our own meager response. The Antiphons today reflect that proper attitude of self-abandonment and God's response to our gift of ourselves. Entrance Antiphons are particularly well suited to teaching us how to pray because they are very often petitionary in nature, begging God to "forgot not the cries of those who seek you" and encouraging us to persevere in reaching out to God. When we pray, we invite Him into our lives to enact change and perform miracles like Peter's walking on the water. Like us, though, Peter doubted and the work of God in his life began to lose PLEASE KEEP HOLY COMFORTER IN MIND DURING YOUR its efficacy. Let us therefore ask for an increase in the theological virtue hope, which helps us believe more firmly that God does not break His promises ("In you have I put my trust"). Jesus, help us in our unbelief!

### FROM THE DIRECTOR OF LITURGY & MUSIC





### **EUCHARISTIC MUSINGS**

PART I Daniel Kirkland

In Father's absence, I have been asked to provide some reflections on the exceptionally broad topic of "the Eucharist". I am no theologian, but I hope to help you understand a little better Our Lord's promise of remaining with us until the end of the world. Understanding leads to love, so my prayer is that you will love Jesus more after having read these impoverished musings of mine. Lord, have mercy!

Eucharistia, the Greek root of Eucharist, literally means "thanksgiving". It is a term rich in symbolic meaning. You will often hear it used in reference to the bread and wine that become the Body and Blood of Our Lord Jesus Christ. The Eucharist, then, is a sacrament, i.e., it becomes what it symbolizes. It is both a reenactment of Calvary, making it present to our time, and at the same time a true offering of Our Lord's Body and Blood to the Father. The Father gives us the gift of His Son that we might offer the Son back to the Father "in atonement for our sins and those of the whole

world". We renew the One Offering made on the Cross. Therefore, the Eucharist is also more broadly speaking the divine liturgy ("public work") that is offered to God the Father by His Son Jesus Christ in the person of the priest and the faithful in union with him. In short, it is the Mystical Body of Christ offering itself to the Father for the salvation of the world in the Mass.

Paraphrasing the Second Vatican Council, the Eucharist is the *source and summit* of our Christian lives. It is the *source* because in receiving the Eucharist we become united to Jesus' sacred humanity, which is free from the power of sin through His Death and Resurrection. We experience this freedom in our souls because God has forgiven us our sins, which shackle us in shame, unworthiness, and guilt. Ultimately, we will experience this freedom in our bodies at the general resurrection of the dead at the end of time.

The Eucharist is also the *summit* because heaven will be the never-ending wedding banquet of the Lamb. We were created to be loved and to love; the experience of God's forgiveness will inspire in us an outpouring of ourselves in worship that begins in this life and is consummated in the next. Our worship is an expression of our *thanksgiving* for deliverance from the power of sin. St. Thomas Aquinas teaches that "God has no need for our worship. It is we who need to show our gratitude for what we have received."

Where there is understanding, there is love. It is important, then, to meditate on the Passion of Christ, calling to mind that every cruel torture and indignity He suffered was for love of us. We could never satisfy God's Justice because even the smallest sin is an infinite offense because God is infinite. Jesus paid the price and did so superabundantly. One drop of His Precious Blood would have been enough to pay our debt, but it was insufficient to express His love for us, so He gave EVERYTHING. The Eucharist, then, is our outpouring of gratitude for so generous a Savior.

We can see, then, that the Liturgy as our expression of worshipful gratitude to God is the most important thing we can do in our lives, and that it ought to have the character of great solemnity. Every Fourth of July, we reenact scenes from the American Revolution, reread the Declaration of Independence, and sing patriotic songs to remind us of the principles upon which this country was founded and to rekindle our dedication to its continued betterment. How could it also not be so many times over in our worship of God?
