## LITURGICAL NOTES

Last week we discussed that Gregorian chants are the model of all sacred music because of their **goodness of forms**. These "forms" refer not only to excellence in musical artistry but to specific musical styles that demonstrate the part of the Mass they pertain to and how those styles facilitate a specific kind of prayer proper to that part of the Mass. We started our discussion of chants with the **Ordinary**, which are the parts of the Mass that do not change from week to week, namely the **Kyrie, Gloria, Credo, Sanctus, and Agnus Dei**. These belong to the Faithful to exercise their office of baptismal priesthood within the context of Mass, united to the office of the ministerial priesthood through which the Eucharist is confected and offered to the Father through the priest. Their general singability and stability of text make them well suited to congregational singing.

There is a wonderful symmetry in the Ordinary that is fruitful to point out: the Kyrie and Angus are penitential litanies asking for mercy. The former prepares our hearts to receive Jesus in the Word and the later to receive Him in the Eucharist. Kyries tend to be more melismatic (containing many notes on a single syllable) because there is less text, so the emphasis is on musical expression. The Gloria and Sanctus are, strictly speaking, hymns because they are songs of praise directed to God. In particular, the Sanctus has received some special attention in Church documents, calling for its being sung as taking priority even over the Gloria (Musicam Sacram 29Sc). Both of these are more syllabic because the focus is on the text. At the center of them all is the Credo, which is syllabic as well because there is a lot of text. Next week, we'll look into the Propers. To be continued!

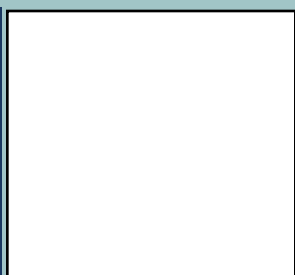
