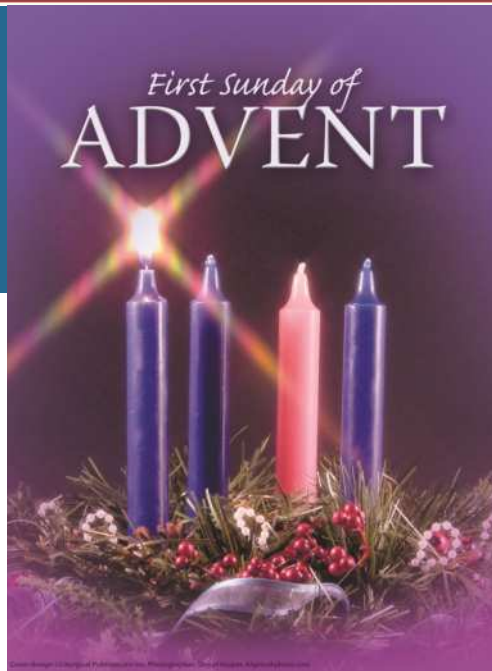

Well... Hello Advent!

Advent 2025 begins this Sunday, November 30. We have now entered into Year A in the Catholic liturgical calendar.

We, the faithful, look forward to Advent. It is a season of preparation and anticipation for the celebration of the birth of Jesus Christ at Christmas. We should take time for reflection, hope, and spiritual renewal as we prepare our hearts and homes for the birth of our Lord and Savior.

The word "Advent" comes from the Latin "adventus," meaning "coming." How appropriate, as we enthusiastically await the arrival of Christ. Dynamic Catholic

During Advent, we Catholics engage in various traditions and practices, such as:

- We make an Advent wreath with four candles, three purple and one pink. Then each week we light a candle.
- We look to our Advent Calendars as we count down the days until Christmas. Some calendars give us insight as to where we might be in our spiritual life with surprises or reflections for each day.
- This is a good time to try to attend Daily Mass more frequently. Attending Mass and engaging in daily prayers are some common practices to help us deepen our faith during this season.
- We can usually find an Advent Penitential Service. Holy Comforter's Advent Penance service will be on Tuesday, December 16th, beginning at 6:00 pm
- And, much like Lent, we look to do more acts of service by serving others or performing acts of kindness as a way to embody the spirit of Advent.

Please take this wonderful opportunity to establish or renew personal and communal traditions to enhance your experience of this sacred season.

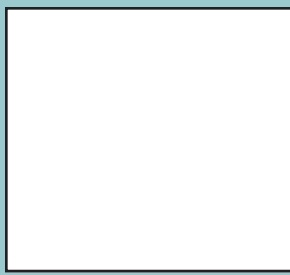
