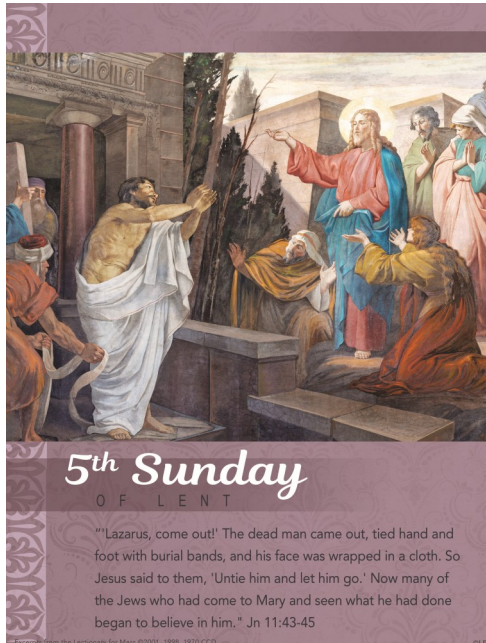

# FROM THE PASTOR



## Suffering That Leads to Victory

Part V

*Rev. Fr. Joseph Mary Lukyamuzi*

**“If we suffer, we shall also reign with him:  
if we deny him, he also will deny us.”**

**2 Timothy 2:12**

If my sufferings joined to Christ and offered up for love of God and neighbor can help save souls, how can I say no to them? I surely can suffer for a little while during this temporary time on earth to help bring the grace of conversion to a soul and to my sanctification so as to be happy for all eternity. What a gift from God that He lets us cooperate and participate in His work of salvation. Just as fire refines gold, trials remove impurities, strengthening character and endurance. Pain is temporary, but it produces a "weight of glory" that outweighs the affliction (2 Cor 4:17).

There is real value in suffering that achieves the good for the salvation of souls and the glory of God. The Blessed Mother also invited us to pray and make sacrifices for sinners. On July 13, 1917, Our Lady of Fatima appeared to

Sister Lucia and said, **“Sacrifice yourselves for sinners; and say often when you make some sacrifice, ‘My Jesus, it is for love of You, for the conversion of sinners, and in reparation for sins committed against the Immaculate Heart of Mary’ ( Messages from Fatima).**

Pope John Paul encourages us when he says, **“It is suffering, more than anything else, which clears the way for the grace which transforms human souls”** . This grace may transform our own soul. This grace may transform the soul of our brother or sister. As Jesus told Saint Faustina (as read in her diary), **“You will save more souls through prayer and suffering than will a missionary through his teachings and sermons alone.”**

The Doctor of the Church, Saint Thérèse of Lisieux, said, **“It’s true, I suffer a great deal — but do I suffer well? That is the question.”** Let us ask God to help us suffer well through the intercession of Our Mother of Sorrows. Give your suffering to God and He will use it. Tell Him, **“Take this pain, Lord, and turn it into something good.”** Let us we never let our suffering go to waste! Remember that our suffering is temporary compared to eternity. In the closing chapters of the final book of the Bible, God makes a beautiful promise to his children: **“And God will wipe away every tear from their eyes; there shall be no more death, nor sorrow, nor crying. There shall be no more pain, for the former things have passed away”** (Rev. 21:3).

If this present world were the end of the story and we had no Savior in which to place our hope, we should be pitied. But praise God, that is not our situation! Cling to your Savior and experience the agony he endured will one day pay off. May the Lord help us to find comfort in our suffering as we look forward to the glory of heaven.
