# FROM THE PASTOR



**"Mercy triumphs over judgment." James 2:13**

**Part II**

*Rev. Fr. Joseph Mary Lukyamuzi*

**"If you, Lord, keep account of sins, Lord, who can stand? But with you is forgiveness and so you are revered." Psalm 130:3-4**

What is mercy if not the boundless love of God, who confronted with human sin, restrains the sentiment of severe justice and, allowing Himself to be moved by the wretchedness of His creatures, drives Himself to the total gift of self, in Jesus 'Cross?

Who can say that he is free from sin and does not need God's mercy? As people of this restless time of ours, wavering between the emptiness of self-exaltation and the humiliation of despair, we have a greater need than ever for a regenerating experience of mercy. As believers we are called to show mercy, as judgment without mercy is promised to those who refuse to be merciful.

It's very important for us to understand God's judgments and how His judgments really are true and righteous altogether. That we can say they are perfect, they are just, they are righteous,

they are good, they are true. And even in our own lives, we can welcome His righteous judgment, which is not to destroy us, but to redeem us, to purify us, to strengthen us, to bring us to much greater maturity and much more being like Jesus.

We need to understand that the God of the Old Testament, and the God of the New Testament is the same God all the way through. He never changed. He never changes. He never will change. All that He was from the very beginning, He will be at the very end. We then dare to say: "His mercy endures forever". Psalm 136. highlights that God's steadfast, loyal love and faithfulness are everlasting. It represents a promise that God's compassionate grace never ceases, sustaining creation, providing deliverance, and offering forgiveness to humanity through all generations.

God's mercy is expressed by having pity, compassion, and kindness toward his people. Mercy is not something God owes us, but something the Lord extends in love by grace to those who do not deserve it. Mercy and judgment met on the cross, and mercy triumphed. Sin was judged, but mercy won the day. Christ died for us and rescued us from our sins. He continues to extend mercy through the finished work of Jesus on the cross. Though we deserved death (eternal separation from our Heavenly Father), we are offered life and that more abundantly. But because of his great love for us, **God, who is rich in mercy**, made us alive with Christ even when we were dead in transgressions —it is by grace you have been saved. According to Ephesians 2:4-5, God's mercy is wonderfully shocking and goes beyond our understanding. It's a gift to us from God and is demonstrated with every breath we take. While mercy triumphs over judgment, refusing mercy will eventually invite judgment. This is disastrous. God's judgment on sin is not unjust, for His judgment is always the result of mercy offered and refused.

We read in history that in 1829 George Wilson was condemned to death for robbing the mail and killing the policeman who was on the way to arrest him. President Andrew Jackson granted him a pardon, but George Wilson refused to accept it. The judge said, "A **pardon is a pardon only when one accepts it. George must die.**" Mercy is mercy when we accept it.
