tion at the Last Supper. And, with the Holy Spirit, the source of grace, wisdom, and the power to live out the Eucharistic life in the world, Prayers and Petitions.

The Blessed Sacrament allows us to focus our hearts and minds on the profound mystery of the Eucharist, the real presence of Jesus Christ, body, blood, soul, and divinity. Through the Eucharist, we encounter the living Christ, truly present in the Sacrifice of the Mass, and dwelling with us in all the Tabernacles of the world. He who sacrificed Himself for us on the cross continues today to give Himself wholly and completely in the Eucharist.

But why both the Blessed Sacrament and the Holy Spirit? Well, it invites us Catholics to deepen our love, reverence, and encounter the living Christ in the Blessed Sacrament, while also allowing the Spirit to guide and transform our lives. The connection to the Holy Spirit, is spiritual as well, because after Christ's resurrection, He sent the Spirit to the disciples on Pentecost (the Feast of the Holy Spirit), which is celebrated 50 days after Easter.

As we all know, the Holy Spirit is the **third person of the Trinity**, bestowing sanctifying graces (wisdom, understanding, counsel, fortitude, piety, fear of the Lord). Therefore, devotion to the Spirit is encouraged alongside the Eucharist, recognizing that the Spirit is never distanced from the second person of the Trinity in the Eucharist and guides all the faithful.

In short, April's dedication to the Blessed Sacrament and the Holy Spirit reflects the Church's liturgical calendar, the timing of Easter and Pentecost, and the inseparable link between Christ's sacrifice and the Holy Spirit's grace. This allows us, the faithful to grow in faith and in reverence for Christ's presence and in openness to the Spirit's guidance.

*Hello again! I am back! Father asked me to cover his bulletin piece while he was away visiting family. I asked him what he would like me to cover. He said for this weekend, he wanted me to share why the month of April is dedicated to the Holy Spirit and the Blessed Sacrament. Then next week, he asked to share why the month of May is dedicated to our Blessed Mother, Mary, Mother of God.*

So here we go...

For centuries, the Church has designated a monthly devotion, and April's focus on the Eucharist is linked to the Sacred Triduum, that is, Holy Thursday, Good Friday, and Holy Saturday, which always fall in April. On Holy Thursday, Christ instituted the Eucharist at the Last Supper, making it the central mystery of the Church's life. When Easter Sunday falls in April, the entire Easter season extends through the month, reinforcing the Eucharist's role as the "source and summit of the Christian life" (CCC 1324)

The Spiritual significance is that the Blessed Sacrament, the real presence of Christ, body, blood, soul, and divinity, is made possible through transubstantia-
