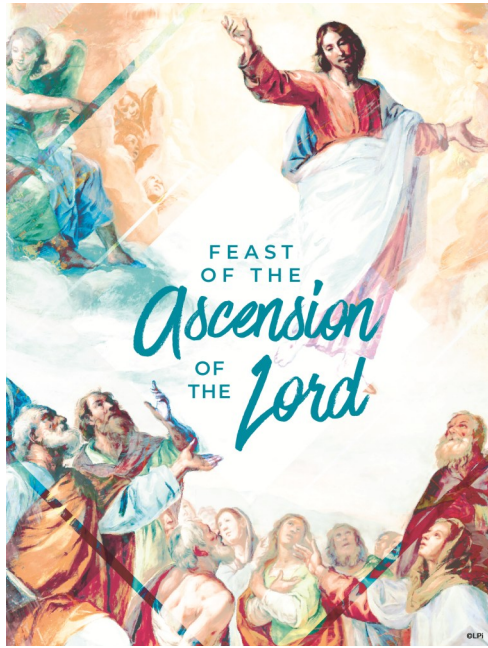

Happy Solemnity of the Ascension of the Lord. The Ascension is a major feast in our Catholic liturgical calendar, celebrated forty days after Easter. As such, it falls on Thursday. However, in most Diocese in the U.S., the feast is transferred to the Sunday after Ascension Thursday, to allow more people to celebrate this great event of our salvation.

We have no schedule changes this week. However, let us begin our preparation for next weekend for our special Feast of Pentecost on Sunday, May 24.

Pentecost always occurs fifty days after Easter Sunday. This is why its date changes every year. Since Easter itself does not have a fixed date and is based on the lunar calendar.

Please join us for our annual Pentecost Potluck on Sunday, May 24th, at 4:00 pm in the church basement. Please bring a dish or two and join us to celebrate this special feast day at our church. Sign up to share a dish for our potluck meal. Continued prayers for a blessed Easter Season.

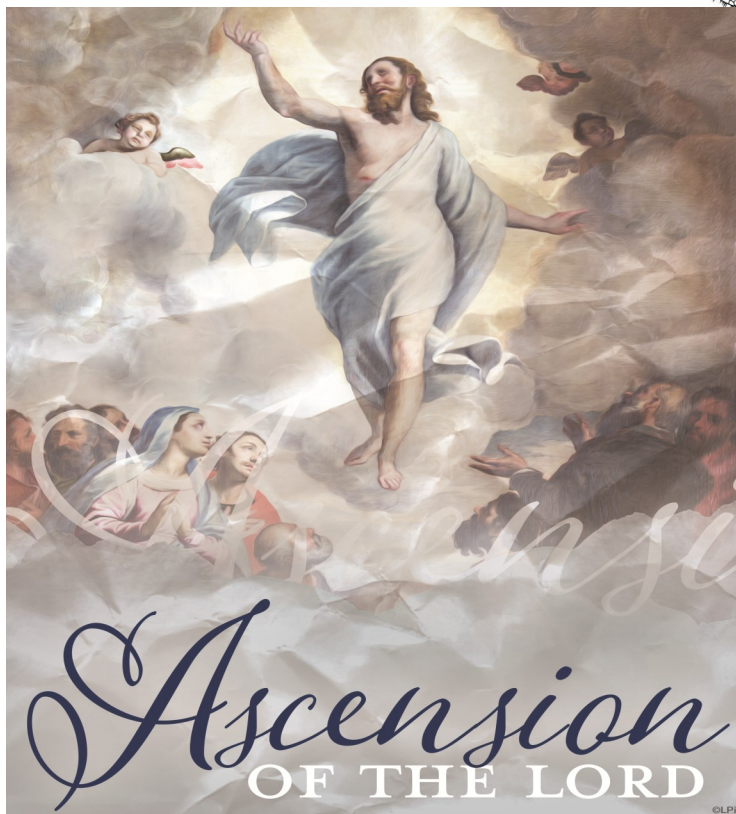

# FROM THE LITURGY COORDINATOR



our Father, gave us Jesus reign as King over all the earth and all time. His authority is above every power and ruler. Even though we cannot see Him, He is still guiding us and giving us strength through the Holy Spirit.

Today is also a call of Commissioning! Jesus leaves His disciples with a mission. He tells them to go and share His message with all nations. This command is not just for them but for every believer. Jesus calls His followers to be witnesses of His love and truth in the world.

Jesus does not send His disciples out alone. He promises that the Holy Spirit will come to help them. The Spirit gives strength, wisdom, and courage to carry out this mission. The same Spirit that He gives us today, guiding us in faith and service. The Ascension also points to the hope of Jesus' return. The disciples watch Him rise into heaven, but they are told He will come again. This promise brings joy and encouragement. It reminds us to stay faithful and focused on living as Jesus teaches us.

Jesus commissions us too! He gives us a mission to go into the whole world. He sends us out to share his message, to baptize, and to teach others to follow him. His words are for us today just as they were for the first disciples.

Happy Feast day of the Solemnity of the Ascension of the Lord. The Ascension is a major feast in our Catholic liturgical calendar, celebrated forty days after Easter. As such, it falls on a Thursday. However, in the U.S., the feast is often celebrated on the Sunday after Ascension Thursday to allow broader participation. It is a holy day of obligation for Catholics, unless excused.

Our Gospel this year will be from Matthew 28: 16-20:

The eleven disciples went to Galilee, to the mountain to which Jesus had ordered them. When they saw him, they worshiped, but they doubted.

Then Jesus approached and said to them,  
*"All power in heaven and on earth has been given to me. Go, therefore, and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you. And behold, I am with you always, until the end of the age."*

This Solemnity commemorates the moment when the risen Jesus, in the presence of his apostles, ascended bodily into heaven, completing his earthly mission and taking his seat at the right hand of the Father. The disciples saw him lifted up into heaven, yet his promise to be with them always gave them courage. God,

As Catholics, we believe that heaven is our true home, and that Jesus has gone before us to prepare a place for us. However, to get there, we must believe and follow Jesus.

**FUN FACT:** The Ascension is believed to have taken place on the Mount of Olives, just outside Jerusalem, near the Chapel of the Ascension, which contains a miraculous imprint of Christ's footprints My Catholic Life!.

Being a Disciple of Jesus is more than knowing facts about Jesus. It is about loving others and leading them closer to God. Jesus showed this love by sacrificing Himself for others. We are now called to show the same love in our words and actions.
