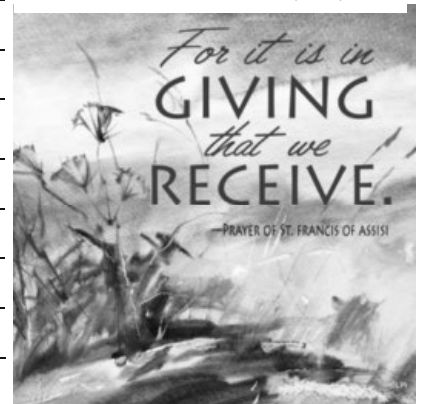

### **The Third Commandment and the Obligation of Sunday Mass.**

Catholics are required to assist at Sunday Mass every week and to assist at Mass on holy days of obligation, not just some of the time, but every week. This is based upon the Third Commandment to "Keep holy the Lord's Day". How do you keep the Lord's day holy? Mass attendance.

Frivolously missing Mass is a Mortal, deadly sin because you are breaking one of the Ten Commandments. Some of us just don't get this. Would you kill someone? NO, that's one of the Ten Commandments. Should you steal? NO, that's one of the Ten Commandments. Then why do we overlook the commandment to keep the Lord's day holy.

Some tell us that they can be with God when they are outdoors, in nature. Some hiking, some resting, others traveling, swimming, fishing, etc.... That's a good way to keep the Lord's Day holy, or is it? Yes, God is in the woods, at the lake, when you rest, travel or visit; God is everywhere. But the Eucharist, the reality of Jesus in the Bread and Wine is not everywhere. It is at Mass.

You wouldn't want to travel on an empty tank of gas in your car. Jesus is truly real and with you at Mass. You receive the grace, the free gift from the breaking open of the Word and the Bread. You fill your spiritual tank up with the fuel you need to be Christ for others the next week. An empty tank means you don't go anywhere.

Are you impatient, judgmental, angry, short-tempered, lonely, or just feeling blah? Maybe it's because you're not assisting at Mass, the source and summit of the life of a Catholic. When you leave out the most important part, smaller things begin to be left out also.

Hermanos: El amor es comprensivo, el amor es servicial y no tiene envidia; el amor no es presumido ni se envanece; no es grosero ni egoísta; no se irrita ni guarda rencor; no se alegra con la injusticia, sino que goza con la verdad. El amor disculpa sin límites, confía sin límites, espera sin límites, soporta sin límites.  
 El amor dura por siempre; en cambio, el don de profecía se acabará; el don de lenguas desaparecerá y el don de ciencia dejará de existir, porque nuestros dones de ciencia y de profecía son imperfectos. Pero cuando llegue la consumación, todo lo imperfecto desaparecerá.

En aquel tiempo, después de que Jesús leyó en la sinagoga un pasaje del libro de Isaías, dijo: “Hoy mismo se ha cumplido este pasaje de la Escritura que acaban de oír”. Todos le daban su aprobación y admiraban la sabiduría de las palabras que salían de sus labios, y se preguntaban: “¿No es éste el hijo de José?”

Jesús les dijo: “Seguramente me dirán aquel refrán: ‘Médico, cúrate a ti mismo’ y haz aquí, en tu propia tierra, todos esos prodigios que hemos oído que has hecho en Cafarnaúm”. Y añadió: “Yo les aseguro que nadie es profeta en su tierra. Había ciertamente en Israel muchas viudas en los tiempos de Elías, cuando faltó la lluvia durante tres años y medio, y hubo un hambre terrible en todo el país; sin embargo, a ninguna de ellas fue enviado Elías, sino a una viuda que vivía en Sarepta, ciudad de Sidón.
