THE RINGING OF THE BELLS IN LITURGY



In this year of Eucharistic Revival and as a Jesuit parish, we are focused on deepening our connection with Christ in the Eucharist. As St. Ignatius tells us, we can deepen our prayer and connect with God in a more tangible way through the use of our five senses. This is especially true within the Liturgy (things to see, smell, taste, feel and hear). Bells have

a longstanding tradition within worship that dates back to our pre-Christ Jewish roots and through formalized Christian worship as it came to develop through the years. Bells (amidst our many other symbols and signs) elevate our worship by helping us focus, and acknowledge the presence of God amongst us, especially in the Eucharist. At the beginning of Mass (to help coordinate between presider and musicians) and during the Eucharistic Prayer when the priest elevates the host and chalice, we will hear bells ring. May we use this sound as a reminder of that which we profess and believe, that through the Word, Priest, People and the Eucharist, Jesus is in our midst. Some see the bells as a dated practice, based on the fact that we now understand the language spoken at Mass, while others remember the bells fondly. We hope that based on the number of distractions and the hard to focus busyness of our lives, the sounding of the bells can help us for a moment to pause, focus and feel Him with us.

During the past year, we have been using the bells at our weekly school Masses. We have been so moved to see how the children focus more intentionally. Children of all grades have shared that this helps them to remember Jesus' presence. They look forward to the sound of the bells drawing their attention to God being present. It is a joy to see the wonder and awe on their faces. This has led us to share this practice with the larger parish community.

In the coming months, our Church will celebrate some of the major feasts on which our faith is built. As our Ignatian spirituality encourages us, may all of our senses be heightened through the richness of these liturgies as a way to further deepen our prayer as one proud Gesu Family. May the sound of the bells remind us all of the miracle that the Eucharist transforming before us and present within and amongst us is indeed Emmanuel, God with us!

the Connection Between the Old and the New Testaments."



First of all, Christ is seen to be present among the faithful gathered in His name; then in his Word, as the Scriptures are read and explained; in the person of the minister; finally and in a unique way under the species of the Eucharist.

Second Sunday of Advent

The presence of Jesus is found in the minister. As the community gathers, the priest is called to serve in a prophetic role as the

minister leads the worship. Through his consecrated life, the priest should reflect the presence of Jesus particularly in the Sacraments and in word and deed.

- 1. Though the priest is called to lead the worship, all, by virtue of their call as priestly people, are encouraged to serve in a variety of ministries. Have I considered becoming a lector, extraordinary minister of communion, an usher or joining the choir?
- 2. We must all pray for vocations to the religious life and priesthood. Have I prayed for vocations to the priesthood and consecrated life? Do I ever encourage young men and women to consider a vocation to the life of ministry in the particular way?
- 3. Seminarians will be running a prayer program during Lent as a part of their training and formation. Consider joining these evenings of prayer and encountering the next generation of priests for Cleveland.

STRENGTHEN AND HEAL YOUR MARRIAGE – PROGRAM BEGINNING JANUARY 26, 2024

The Retrouvaille program is designed to help married couples develop improved ways of communicating and relating to each other in order to overcome challenges which have left them feeling frustrated, hurt, distant, or even hopeless. Retrouvaille, which means rediscovery, is supported by the Catholic Diocese of Cleveland, and is open to couples of all faiths. This program consists of a weekend experience and six follow up sessions. 


