## From the Desk of Fr. John Ledford

This weekend we return to our regular schedule, so to speak, as we come together to celebrate the Thirty-second Sunday in Ordinary Time. As the liturgical year heads towards its ending with the Solemnity of Our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe on 22 November, we begin to reflect on the final time. This is one of the great mysteries of Faith and what we are aiming for.

Our First Reading this weekend is taken from the Book of Wisdom. The writer sees Wisdom as a person intimately related to God. As human beings, we are constantly challenged by life. Life gives us opportunity after opportunity to learn. As we learn, as we discover different aspects of life, it's the wonder of Wisdom and God's providence that we are able to continue with life.

Matthew, as he shares Jesus' parable to the ten virgins, illustrates Wisdom in Matthew's manner. In life we learn to be prepared, to anticipate. As Jesus relates this parable, we experience that acted out. Five brought extra lamp oil, five did not. Perhaps this reminds us of an incident in our lives when we have been caught "flat footed". Jesus is challenging people to be prepared for the final times.
