From the Desk of Fr. John Ledford

This weekend we come together as we celebrate the Thirty-third Sunday in Ordinary Time. This is the next to the last weekend in Ordinary time. Next weekend we will celebrate the final weekend in this Liturgical Year as we celebrate the Solemnity of Our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe.

Our first reading is taken from Proverbs. To reflect on this reading, perhaps it is helpful to understand things in light of the culture of the time it was written. In that time and place, women and children had no legal basis, for want of a better way to phrase it. For this reason, time and time again, the prophets keep pointing out the need to care for the widows and orphans. Families were challenged, even as presently, to care for the needs of their families in case of death. Women have challenged Church down through the ages to do just that.

Likewise, as Matthew relates this incident in Jesus' ministry, again we see the challenge. It is amusing to witness some who go on a journey with no thought of how needs are going to be taken care of. Most Parish Communities have witnessed people coming to their door with a need for gasoline, for example, to get to some location because of... (you fill in the blank). Evidently, they are not "prepared", they have not thought through the process of their journey. Have you thought through your journey to heaven?
