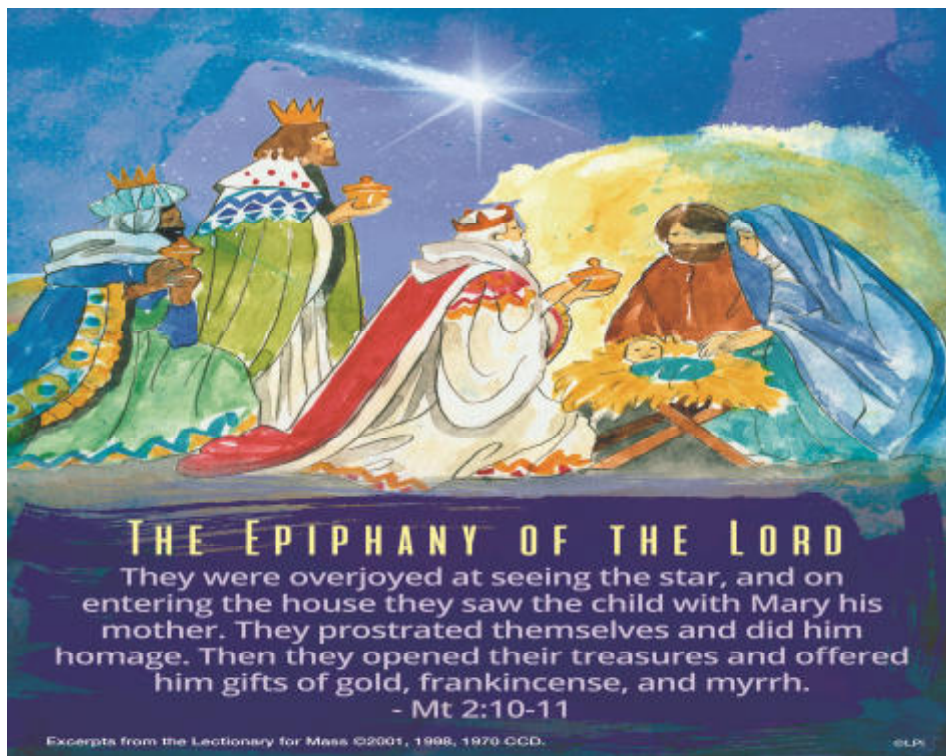

From the Desk of Fr. John Ledford

This weekend we come together to continue our Christmas journey with the celebration of the Solemnity of the Epiphany of the Lord. Epiphany is a word that we use every day, right? Likely not! The objective of this celebration is to remind us that God is made known every day in our lives. The challenge for us is to stand back and reflect on how that happens in our lives.

For our first reading taken from what scholars call “Third Isaiah”, we hear the prophet reflecting to the ancient Israelites the rebirth of Jerusalem. The Israelites have returned from Babylon to find that what they expected (a beautiful city) was really a “pile of burnt rock”. Third Isaiah points out that in time Jerusalem will arise and become resplendent in its beauty.

In our gospel passage from Matthew, we have the story of the Magi. Matthew is beginning, in his way, to challenge these early Jewish Christians. Perhaps they had gotten complacent in their newfound faith. Perhaps they were thinking that they could rest easy now. After all they were “God’s chosen people”. They did not have to reach out and share their newfound Christian Faith with anyone.
