From the Desk of Fr. John Ledford

This weekend we continue in our annual liturgical journey as we celebrate the Third Sunday in Ordinary Time. As we do so, we are asked to reflect on our lives and what we are about in life. No one likes to find fault in our life, but yet part of life is learning from our faults or failures.

We all, most likely, are familiar with the story of Jonah. As we recall, Jonah was an individual who tried everything that he could think of to avoid God's call. Life is full of opportunities to answer God's call. We could be like Jonah, we could, in our way, run from God's Call. God reaches out to us time and time again, as He did with Jonah, and given us an opportunity to reform, repent, and follow God's call.

Likewise, as Mark shares this story in Jesus' ministry, we also are invited to look at our gift of life. Mark, if you reflect on it, really does not go into great detail of Jesus' experience. Rather instead, Mark challenges us to look at Jesus' activities and how they affect each of us. In short, we are challenged to proclaim our faith and allow faith to be seen in our life's activities. We just cannot sit, but rather are invited to join in Christian Action.
