





We continue to prayerfully respond to this egregious act; and any other act against the dignity of children, life, and our world. May God continue to bring comfort to all hurting as we pray Eternal Rest we grant unto them O Lord, and May Perpetual Light Shine Upon them. Amen+)

A blessed Pentecost Sunday to you as we pray for an outpouring of the Holy Spirit upon all of us anew! Further, it is the Spirit that consoles, strengthens, and guides us among other things. It is providential that we hear the Easter Sunday Gospel as this day closes the Easter Season. We hear this Gospel to give us a challenge to live out the meaning of Easter everyday and that meaning guided by these two realities:

- 1. He IS Risen
- 2. The Spirit Guides Us

If we begin each day with that on our mind, hearts, and in prayer, then we continue to live out the glory of Easter and the power of the Risen Jesus daily! Last weekend I mentioned information regarding the Cemetery; here it is again in case you missed it: This is also a great time to give you some information regarding our cemetery as we are in need of more land. If you know of any available land in the vicinity, please let me know by contacting the Office by phone or email.

Please join me in prayerful congratulations to all of our High School and College Graduates and keep them (and all teachers) in your prayers as they strive to bring their God-Given talents to our world! We are very proud of you and know of our prayers for you at this milestone in your lives. If you see any of our graduates, please be sure to say "well done!"

Thanks for all of your help and support we are now able to move forward with the first phase of our flooring project which begins this week in the Sanctuary, which will disrupt us for two weeks. With this happening, please note the following as the church will remain open for prayer, but with some modifications during this time:

- 1. As the church remains accessible for personal prayer 24 hours/day, you will be able to pray in the Cry-Room as the Tabernacle will be located there (the main Sanctuary and Nave of the Church will be temporarily closed off).
- 2. Daily Mass will be temporarily celebrated in the Gathering Space.
- 3. Weekend Masses will be celebrated in the church as usual; but it may be dusty as we ask your patience until the job is completed.

We were supposed to move on this project last year, but I delayed it because of the Pandemic and Supply Chain issues. However, the contactor was able to lock us into last year's price quote instead of the increase that it would've been this year. Again, this has been made possible by your gifts to the CSA last year as well as your support of the Capital Improvement Funds.

As we go forward from this Easter Season, may we keep each other in prayer.
