4 PROGRAM HIGHLIGHTS

Independent Living will assist people with disabilities in exercising more freedom and control over their lives. Whenever possible, the individual will develop their own goals, direct delivery of services and experience self-advocacy at all times.

Budgeting

An Independent Living Specialist will help you create a budget and make informed suggestions on how to cut costs and work savings into your plans.



Loan Closet

FREE (gently used) medical equipment including wheelchairs, walkers, canes, crutches, shower benches, raised toilet seats, portable ramps, and more based on availability.



Peer Counseling

An Independent Living Specialist is someone who's walked a mile in your shoes. We are here to listen without judging. If you are interested in setting goals, we can help establish a plan and provide support as you work towards those goals.



Job Search

There is an Independent Living Specialist available to help you with all your job search needs. Computer access, assistance with on-line applications, cover letters, resumes, interview tips, references and more.



Housing Search and Rapid Rehousing

We can provide a housing list, an apartment guide and application assistance to anyone with a disability.

The Rapid Rehousing Program will pay rent and security deposits for people who are homeless. Eligibility must be determined according to HUD guidelines.



Transportation

We can assist people with transportation to and from our office to meet with an Independent Living Specialist. In addition, we can deliver loan closet equipment, food pantry supplies and pharmacy items to your door.

TAKING CONTROL

Consumer Directed Personal Care Aide

Taking Control is a unique program that can allow eligible Medicaid recipients to remain independent in their own home with the assistance of a Personal Care Aide (PCA). Assistance with daily living activities can be key to being self-sufficient and remaining in one's community. The person in the home becomes the employer of their PCA; hiring who they wish, including a relative. Our Staff can help with finding a PCA if needed, then ILGR will take care of the PCA's payroll and all of the Dept. of Labor aspects of employment. The service is paid for by Medicaid and allows a person to be "Taking Control" of their own care; hence Independent Living has labeled their program as such. When you or your family are overwhelmed by the increasing need for assistance, consider calling us for guidance in enrolling in Taking Control. We can assist with phone calls, evaluations and finding a Personal Care Aide; or we can just explain the process.



ILGR WELCOMES NEW STAFF



Shuntynia Robinson

Independent Living of the Genesee Region welcomes Shuntynia Robinson to our staff. Ms. Robinson will assist people with disabilities in the Genesee, Orleans, and Wyoming County (GOW) Region as a Medicaid Application Assistance Program (MAAP) Facilitated Enroller. In this position, Ms. Thompson will assist individuals who are over 65 years of age, legally blind, or receiving Social Security Disability in applying for Medicaid insurance by determining the type of Medicaid coverage that is best for them, and even assist in completing the application and collecting necessary documentation to submit with the Medicaid application. Additionally, she will conduct outreach activities to educate, engage and enroll qualified individuals who live in the GOW Region.



Ida Caldwell

Independent Living of the Genesee Region welcomes Ida Caldwell to our staff. In her new position, Ida will be assisting individuals to apply for, and navigate, the programs and services offered through Independent Living, including, but not limited to, coordinating housing evaluations and program options for persons experiencing homelessness or at risk of homelessness, including Rapid Rehousing. Due to the COVID-19 pandemic she also helps with applications for the Emergency Solutions Grants – Corona Virus (ESG-CV) Program as funded by the CARES Act. ILGR is delighted that Ida is bringing her experience to serve the GOW region in her new capacity.

Independent Living of the Genesee Region welcomes Christine Perrin and Katie Cotter to our staff. In their new positions as NY Connects Independent Living Specialists, Christine and Katie will provide application assistance and information and referral. NY Connects is a program designed to offer free, unbiased information and assistance for individuals with disabilities of all ages. It provides linkage to long term services and supports, such as home care, transportation and meals. The goal is to help individuals remain in their homes as long as possible. In order to provide seamless delivery of services for seniors, the NY Connects program aligns the Office for the Aging from each County with the Independent Living Center and the Department of Social Services. This delivery system is called No Wrong Door and the goal is to ensure that people receive access to the services they need.
