HE SENT THEM OUT TWO BY TWO

In the Gospel this weekend, we hear of our Lord appointing 72 others, sent out ahead of him on mission in pairs of two. The image on the cover of the bulletin is by **Jacques** (James) **Tissot**. He was a successful French painter and illustrator. Before moving to London in 1871, his works often depicted fashionable, modern Parisian scenes and high society. A friend and mentor of **Edgar Degas** (a French Impressionist), Tissot also painted scenes from the Bible. His father enjoyed a career as a drapery merchant. His mother assisted her husband in the family business and designed hats. A devout Catholic, his mother instilled pious devotion in the future artist from a very young age. The involvement of his parents in the fashion industry is believed to have been an influence on his painting style, as he depicted women's clothing in fine detail. By the time he was 17, he knew he wanted to pursue a career in painting. While his father was opposed, Tissot gained his mother's support for his chosen vocation. As he neared the age of 50, he had a revival of his Catholic faith, which led him to spend the rest of his life making paintings about biblical events, returning to traditional, representational styles and narratives in watercolor. To assist in his completion of biblical illustrations, Tissot traveled to the Middle East in 1886, 1889, and 1896, to make studies of the landscape and people. His series of 365 illustrations showing the life of Christ were shown to critical acclaim and enthusiastic audiences in Paris (1894-95), London (1896), and New York (1898-99), before being purchased by the Brooklyn Museum of Art in 1900.

While we are all commissioned and sent on mission at the conclusion of every Eucharistic celebration, some are called and sent on actual mission. Our parish patron, Saint Noel, was one himself. As Catholics, we are called to help support the efforts of missionaries each year. Next weekend, we will welcome our very own parishioner, **Chris Janezic**, who has long been associated with **COAR**. COAR is a peace mission and children's outreach, established in the United States to facilitate fundraising in El Salvador, our diocesan partnership which formed in 1964 during Vatican II. Chris will have the opportunity to speak at all Masses. I know for many of us, our means are presently stretched, but we remain invited to be as generous as we find ourselves able.


