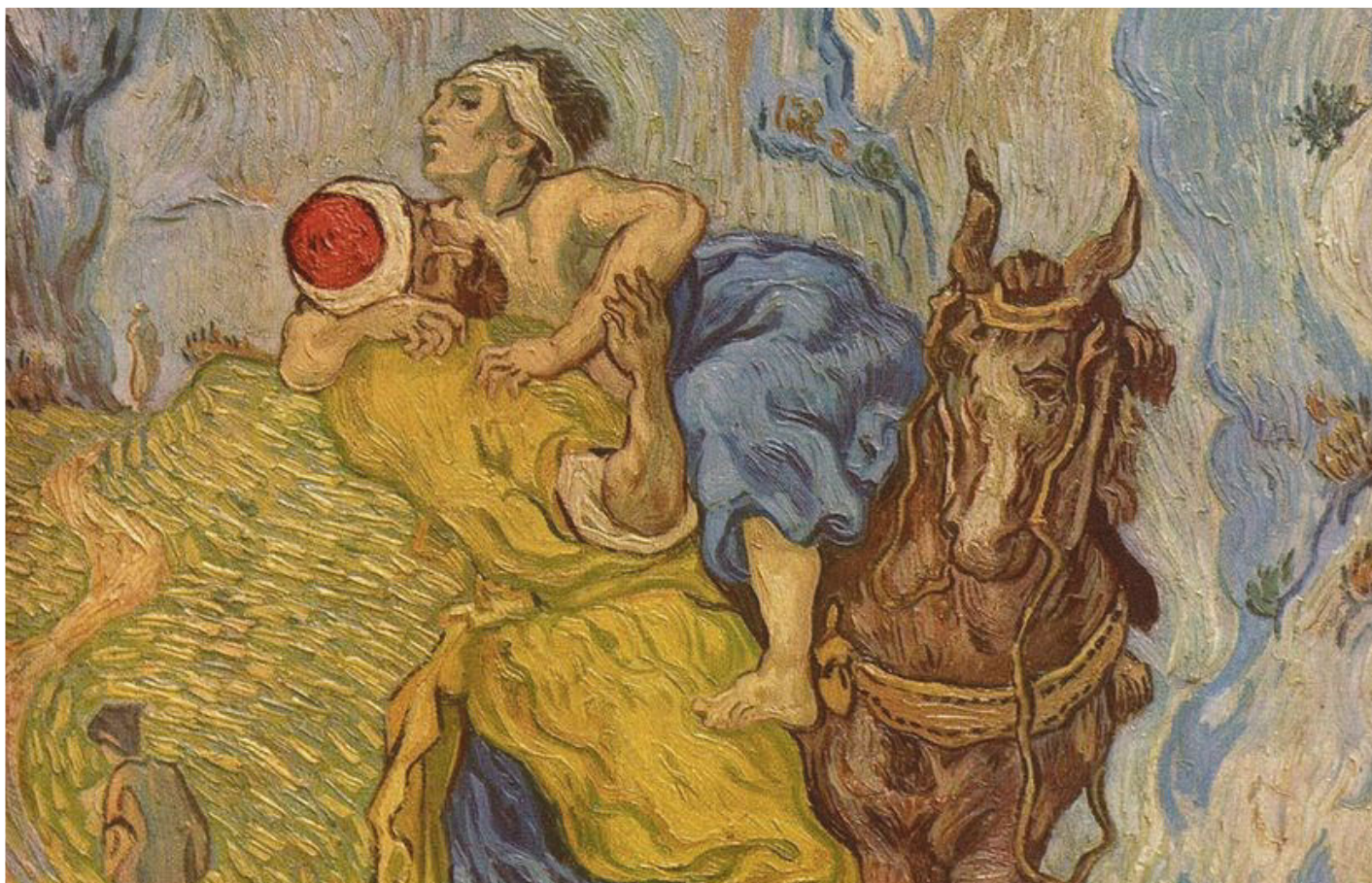

FROM THE DESK OF ANTHONY CAMINO



COAR, which stands for the **Community Oscar Arnulfo Romero**, will be making a mission appeal this weekend and asking for your donations, prayers, and interest. We are pleased to welcome COAR Board Member and St. Noel parishioner, **Chris Janezic**, to offer the appeal.

COAR, located in Zaragoza, El Salvador, was founded in 1980 by a Cleveland Diocese Mission Team priest, **Fr. Ken Myers**, during El Salvador's brutal civil war. Fr. Ken and fellow Cleveland Mission Team members, **Sr. Dorothy Kazel**, OSU, and **Jean Donovan** (murdered December 2, 1980), began gathering orphans from refugee camps and bringing them back to the Mission's parish of Zaragoza.

COAR is now known as the "Children's Village" in El Salvador with 1,000 day students, 50 in foster care, a medical and dental clinic, pharmacy, and trade shops (such as baking and tailoring). It is administered directly by the Archbishop of San Salvador through his Vicariate of Human Development. COAR's local office is located at the Center for Pastoral Leadership in Wickliffe, and is an affiliated charity of the Diocese of Cleveland.

With over 30 employees, COAR strengthens the regional economy. COAR buzzes with optimism and vitality; however, El Salvador and COAR's children remain impoverished. To protect the most vulnerable requires food, shelter, and housemothers. To educate the children to modernize their economy requires updated computers and new classrooms. To get the best teachers and treat them fairly requires wages near the Salvadoran national average. Please help us respond to the needs of the most impoverished among us and help them build a better future.

Donations can also be brought to the parish office during the week or placed in the collection basket next weekend, July 16/17. Checks can be made payable to St. Noel Parish with "COAR" in the memo. Thank you for your support of the Church's missionary activity throughout the world and for your warm welcome and generosity extended to Chris Janezic and COAR.

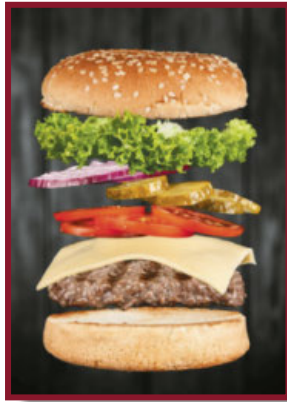

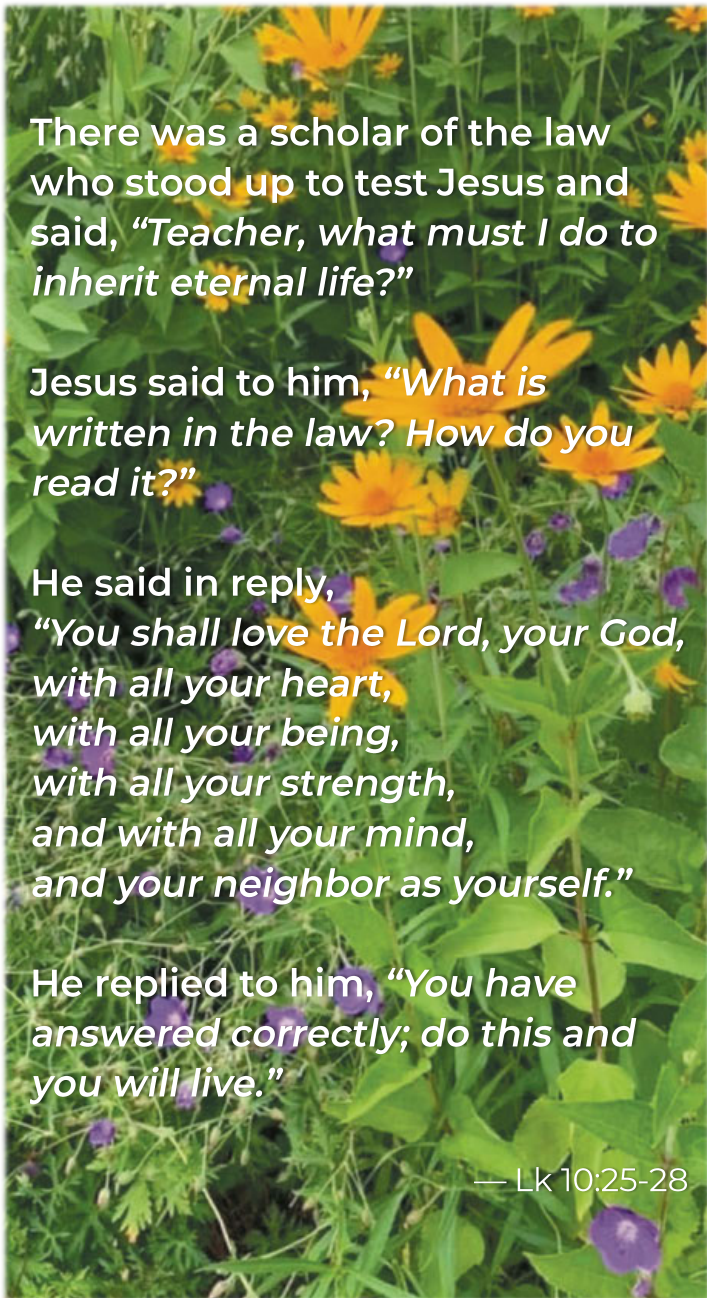
