WORLD DAY FOR GRANDPARENTS AND ELDERLY



Last year, Pope Francis established the fourth Sunday in July as “**World Day for Grandparents and Elderly.**” This Sunday was chosen as it is in close proximity to the feast of the grandparents of Jesus, St. Joachim and St. Anne, traditionally celebrated on July 26. Next weekend (**July 23-24**), we’ll pray for our elders at all Masses. On that Sunday evening, we will celebrate them with an **Ice Cream**

Sunday from 7-8 PM on the lawn near the **Banquet Center.** We invite parish grandparents and elders to bring their family members; we invite all parishioners to invite grandparents and special “wisdom figures” who live nearby. Bring your lawn chairs and blankets and enjoy an ice cream novelty treat. Pope Francis has written a new message to the grandparents and elders of the world. Saint Noel will again provide a booklet containing the entire message. Here is a sneak peek:

“We grandparents and elderly people have a great responsibility: to teach the women and men of our time to regard others with the same understanding and loving gaze with which we regard our own grandchildren. We ourselves have grown in humanity by caring for others, and now we can be teachers of a way of life that is peaceful and attentive to those in greatest need. This attitude may be mistaken for weakness or resignation, yet it will be the meek, not the aggressive and the abusive, who will inherit the earth (cf. Mt. 5:5).”



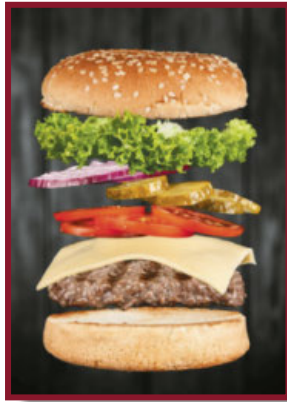
