



WORLD DAY FOR GRANDPARENTS AND ELDERLY

SECOND YEAR



Last year, Pope Francis established the fourth Sunday in July to be "World Day for Grandparents and the Elderly," given its close proximity to the feast of the grandparents of Jesus, St. Joachim and St. Anne, traditionally celebrated on July 26. This weekend, we'll offer a blessing for all our respected elders at each Mass. Sunday evening, we will continue to celebrate them with an Ice Cream "Sunday" from 7-8 PM

on the lawn near the Banquet Center. We invite parish grandparents and elders to bring their family members, and all parishioners to invite grandparents and special "wisdom figures" who live nearby. Bring your lawn chairs and blankets and enjoy an ice cream novelty treat.

Last weekend, Michele shared that Pope Francis had written a new letter to the grandparents and elders of the world. As was offered last year, once again we have formatted his new text into small booklets. Copies are available to take for yourselves, or to give to your grandparents and the elderly who will undoubtedly appreciate his loving words.

SCAPULARS

July 16 was the feast of **Our Lady of Mount Carmel**, and the brown scapular is associated with her. Wearing the scapular and joining in prayer have helped many deepen their devotion to Mary and strengthen their Catholic faith. **Pope Pius XII** called the brown scapular "a sign of consecration to the Immaculate Heart of Mary," but adds, "the scapular is not superstitious ... one is not saved from hell merely by wearing it. No, for it is a sign that they must live their lives in total obedience to God and trust in him, through and with the Immaculate Heart of Mary."
