

LIVING THE SACRAMENTAL LIFE OF THE CHURCH

"Participation in the sacraments is foundational to sustain the faithful in union with the very life of the Trinity" (USCCB). The Seven Sacraments continue the saving work of Jesus until he comes again, and form the center of the celebration of the Christian mystery. Through the ministry of the Church, all are invited to hear the Good News, follow Christ, and share in these saving mysteries: mysteries that symbolize, make possible, realize, and nurture the grace of the sacraments in the baptized.

Last Sunday at our 11 AM celebration, we welcomed **Janis** Lyons, into full communion with the Roman Catholic Church, with her husband, Thad, as her sponsor. Already a baptized Christian, Janis made her Profession of Faith with us as we recited the Creed, was confirmed, and ultimately united herself fully with the Universal Church as she received the Eucharist for the first time. Are you, or is someone you know, interested in becoming a fully-initiated Catholic? The Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA) is the process by which unbaptized adults, or those already baptized into other faith traditions, join the Catholic Church. It is also a way for baptized Catholics to complete their sacraments of initiation (Confirmation and Eucharist) if they did not happen to do so when they were younger. RCIA sessions begin this fall. This process begins with a nocommitment period of inquiry, in which the individual explores how God has worked within their life, where God might be leading them, and is able to discuss any questions they might have about the Church. PREGNANCY RESOURCES


