



SACRAMENTAL PREPARATION

RCIA

Are you interested in becoming a fully initiated member of the Catholic Church? The Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA) is the process by which unbaptized adults or those baptized into other faith traditions join the Catholic Church. It is also a way for baptized Catholics to complete the sacraments of initiation (Confirmation and First Communion) if they did not do so when they were younger. RCIA sessions will begin this fall. This process starts with a nocommitment period of inquiry in which we will explore how God has worked in our lives, where God may be leading us, and discuss any questions participants have about the Church. BLOOD DRIVE


Our next blood drive is scheduled for **Aug**. **14** in the **Banquet Center**. Schedule online at redcrossblood.org
