




OUR MISSION

Whether it is someone needing care, a wrong that must be rectified, an injustice that must be addressed, or someone in need of a helping hand, the lens through which we view life (and even the rules by which we live) can prevent us from stopping and acting. Whether it's an obsession with being on time, a compulsion to complete tasks according to a schedule, or a rigidity with not breaking a

law or fear of taking a risk, we miss daily opportunities to show mercy. We often fail in our duty to be a good neighbor, especially when it involves brothers and sisters remote from us whom we have never met. The pain of the world is our pain. God's law of love, mercy, and compassion is not something remote. It's already within us and very near. All we have to do is open our eyes and carry it out. ©LPi

WORLD DAY OF GRANDPARENTS AND THE ELDERLY ON JULY 24

The second World Day for Grandparents and the Elderly will be celebrated throughout the universal church. The theme chosen by the Holy Father is "In old age they will still bear fruit" (Psalm 92:15) and emphasizes how grandparents and the elderly are a value and gift both for society and the Church. It is also



an invitation to reconsider and value grandparents and the elderly who are too often kept on the margins of families, civil and ecclesial communities. Their experience of life and faith can contribute to building societies that are aware of their roots and capable of dreaming of a future based on greater solidarity.


