## WORLD DAY OF GRANDPARENTS AND THE ELDERLY ON JULY 24

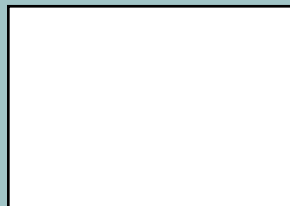
