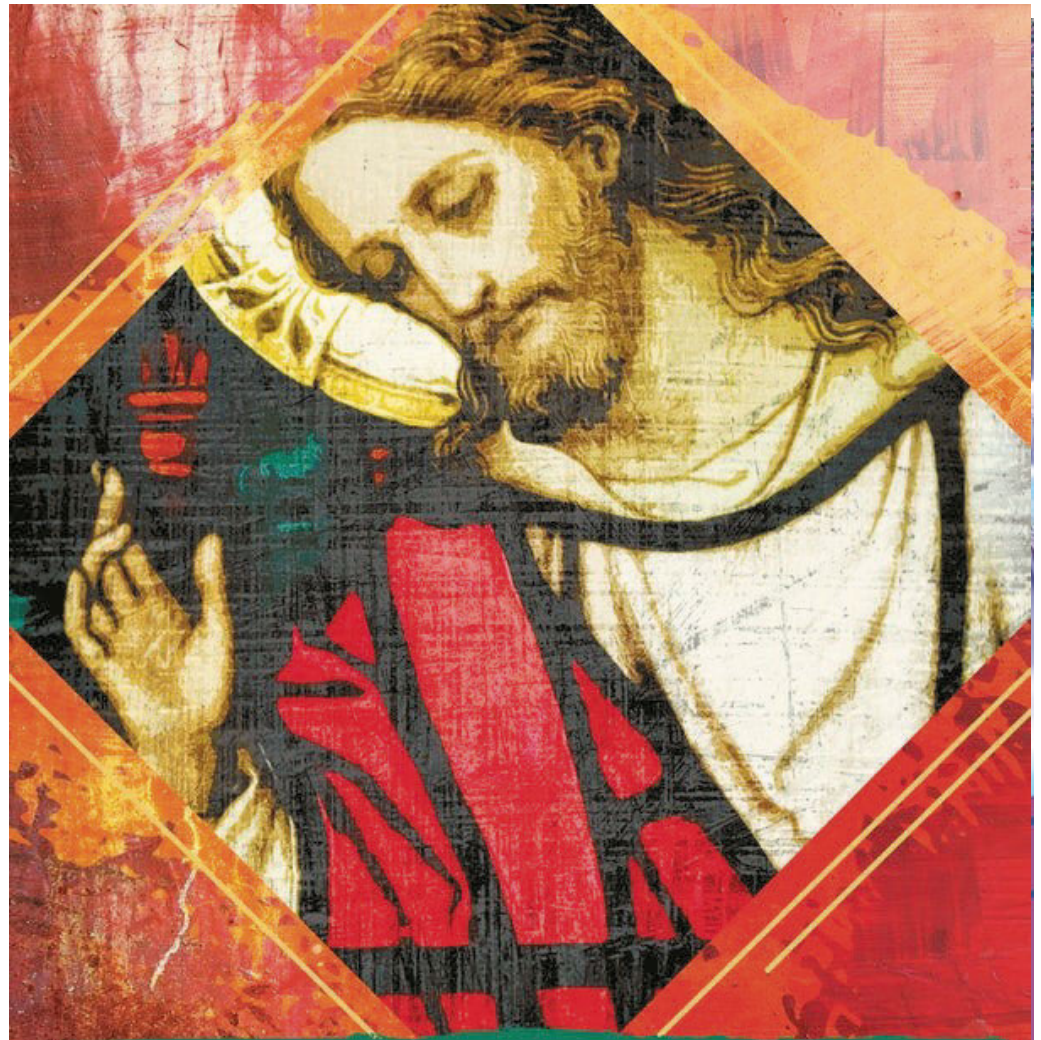

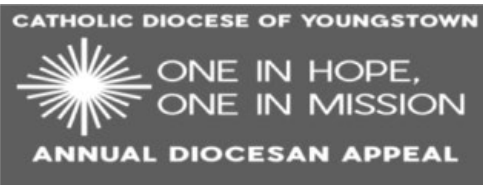


WELCOME!

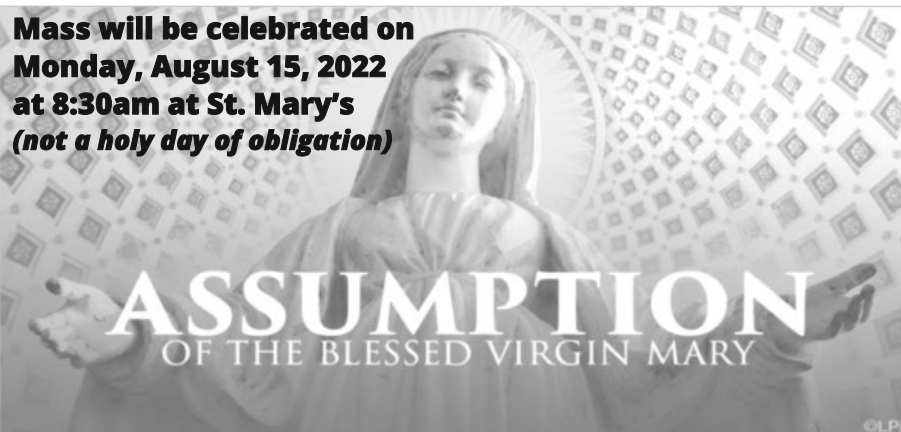

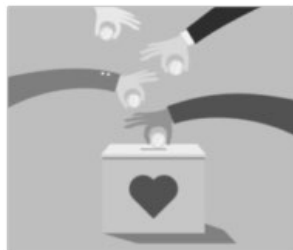
