

DÍA DE REYES

Christmas might be a season traditionally spent at home, with your family and close friends. Yet, the Christmas season also brings the opportunity for my students to learn about different traditions that are celebrated in the Spanish Speaking World. Students learned about **el día de los** *Reyes Magos* (Three Kings Day) a Spanish tradition celebrated during the Eve and day of **Epifania** (Epiphany). Children around Mexico (and Latin America and Spain) place their shoes near the nativity scene on Jan. 5th and anxiously await gifts that the *reyes magos* (the wise men) will bring the next morning. The evening is celebrated with a culinary pastry called **Rosca de Reyes**, Tradition calls for a small plastic infant figure to be placed inside to represent baby Jesus. Whoever gets the baby figurine in their slice, in many cases, is obligated to host a dinner for others. What fun traditions!

Women's Winter Bible Study at Sandusky Parishes Walking with Purpose


