LIVING THE FAITH

WEEKLY REFLECTION

On Saturday morning, six teens from our parish received the sacrament of Confirmation, obtaining the the gifts of the Holy Spirit. We were especially blessed to celebrate this activity of the Holy Spirit with Bishop Daniel E. Thomas of our Diocese of Toledo. Bishop Thomas prayed over the candidates and anointed them on the forehead with Sacred Chrism, sealing them with the gifts of Wisdom, Understanding, Knowledge, Counsel, Courage, Piety and Awe.



These teens have spent the last seven months preparing for the sacrament by studying the "Chosen" program from Ascension Press. During their course of study, they received instruction in who God

is, salvation history, divine revelation, the mission of Jesus, why being Catholic is important and the last four things (death, judgment, heaven and hell). They studied the sacraments, with special emphasis on Baptism, Eucharist, Reconciliation, the Sacrament of the Sick and Confirmation. They studied the importance of prayer, the Holy Spirit, the gifts and fruits of the Spirit, the Beatitudes, the human virtues, the spiritual virtues, the corporal and spiritual works of mercy, the Blessed Mother, and steps to becoming a better disciple and missionary of Jesus.

It takes several people to help with our Confirmandi preparation for the sacrament. It starts with the parents and sponsor who answer questions along the way and provide encouragement. Sandy Smith, Deacon Jim Tokarsky and Father Paul Schreiner provided spiritual guidance and assistance. Dale and Pam Terschak provided lunch for our Rite of Commitment luncheon, and the staff of the Damascus Catholic Mission Campus in Centerburg, Ohio, who hosted the students for their Confirmation retreat. Finally, you — the community of St. Mary Parish —for your support and prayers.

It is my prayer that these teens "rise up" like the Risen Christ to become active participants in our parish community and continue to grow in their Catholic faith.

LITURGICAL QUESTION BOX: WHO CAN OFFER ANOINTING OF THE SICK?

The Letter of James speaks to us of the ancient tradition of a special anointing and blessing of those who are sick: "Is there anyone sick among you? Let him send for the presbyters of the Church and let them pray over him, anointing him with oil in the name of the Lord ... If he has committed any sins, they will be forgiven him" (5:14, 15b). This passage forms the foundation for the theology of the sacrament that we call "Anointing of the Sick." In keeping with what we read in the Letter of James and the ancient tradition of the Church, the anointing of a person of who sick or dying many only be performed by a priest or bishop.

Although deacons and other members of the Church are not able to celebrate the sacrament with a person who is sick, we can read Sacred Scripture and pray with and for those who are ill. Resources like the Book of Blessings also contain special blessings that can be celebrated by deacons or lay ministers. In the end, we want to be sure that we show a special care and concern for the sick, helping them to always experience God's loving comfort through made tangible through our acts of charity and service.






Sacred Music Concert in Swanton




