

WEEKLY REFLECTION By Deacon Im Tokarsky

Greetings to the Good People of God!



What a blessing it is to be home after my adventure of walking with Joy in Kansas last week! It did not go as planned, and we were unable to finish all 60 miles of the pilgrimage. We did complete over two days of walking in the middle of very rural Kansas. Rain, mud, and blisters dampened our resolve to finish on foot. We did get to our goal via car and we will complete the mileage here in the coming days as my blisters continue to heal. We have plenty of colorful stories to tell from our adventure. I am ever more grateful for my bed, indoor plumbing, and a truly understanding wife! We were most compelled by the three witnesses who shared life-saving miracles as a result of the intercession of Fr. Kapaun. I have included the intercession prayer below. Servant of God Emil Kapaun, pray for us.

We are also grateful to have Fr. George Kintiba, SVD celebrate our Masses this weekend from Cross Catholic Outreach. Please continue to be generous to this wonderful group which provides so much to those in great need.

This weekend we celebrate Trinity Sunday! In Church circles, it is often called "Heresy Sunday" because preaching something as complicated as the Trinity in 5-10 minutes can often go sideways. That is why in the Nicene Creed, which we recite each week, we use words like "begotten", "consubstantial", and "proceeds". These are not frequently used words in our everyday vocabulary, but they convey a sense of the relationship between the Father, and the Son, and The Holy Spirit. Notice that in approaching the Trinity, the word relationship is key to understanding God. The Trinity means we have been created by a God of relationship for relationship. Let us pray to continue to build our relationships with each other and with our loving God!




