



Dear Parishioners,

Merry Christmas!

I want to thank you for all you have given me: opportunities to serve, to learn, to grow in my life of service among you. Thank you for the relationships we have shared. And now as we look ahead to a new year, and new adventures for all of us, let’s hold each other in prayer. We remember, we celebrate, we believe that Emmanuel, God-with-us, goes ahead and alongside and behind and within us, now and always.

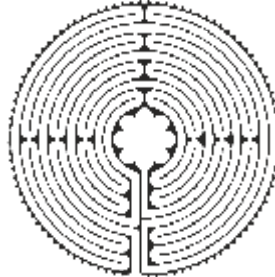

On Monday, January 3, 2022 starting at 10:00am you are welcome to spend an hour walking the Labyrinth in Trivison Hall.



The labyrinth that is in our possession is a replica of the one built into the stone floor of Chartres Cathedral in France. Ours is painted on canvas, but it still evokes a sense of history. In the middle ages, visitors to Chartres and other cathedrals would walk the labyrinth designs built into the naves as the spiritual culmination of their long pilgrimages.

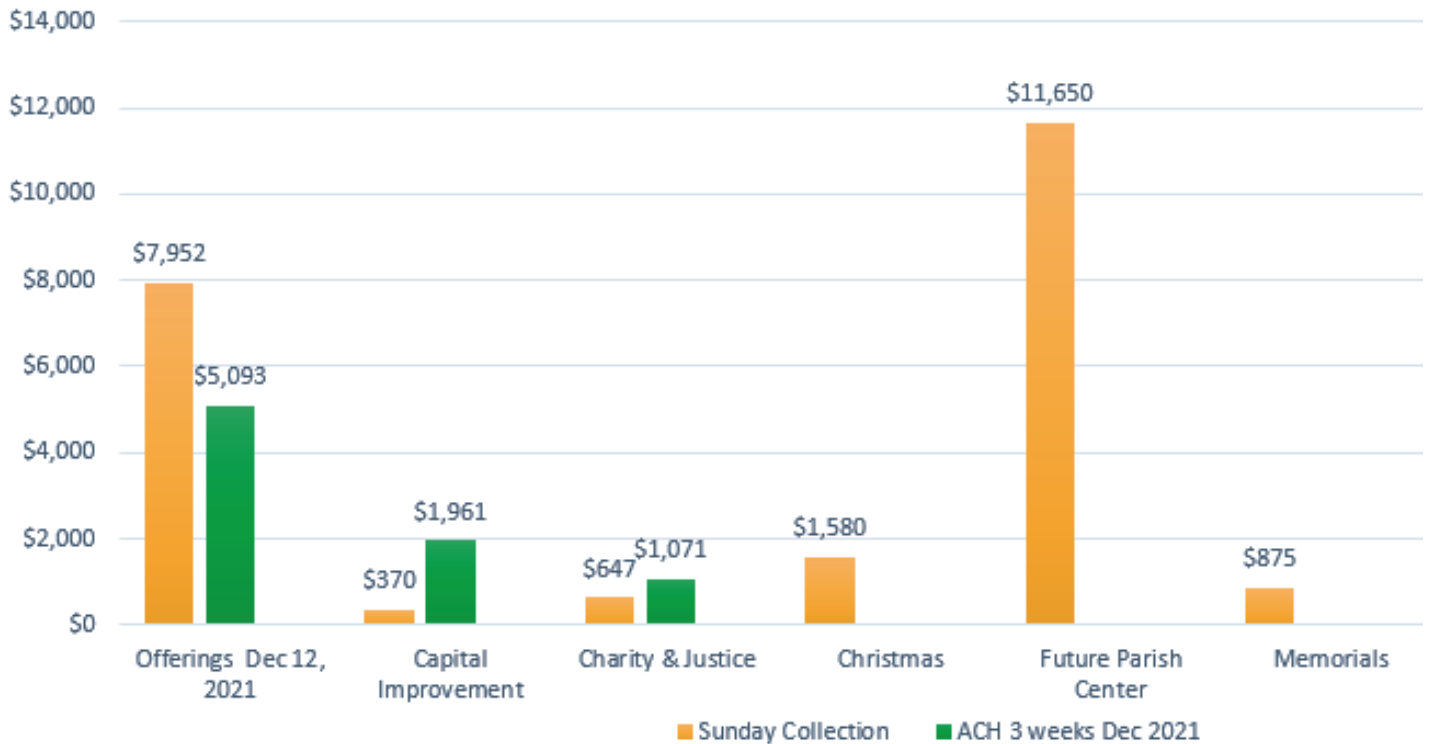
