

Martin Luther King Day is observed this year on Monday, January 17, 2022.

The MLK Day of Service inspires hundreds of thousands of Americans to come together to serve their community. Citizens in all 50 states deliver meals, refurbish schools and community centers, and collect food and clothing. Volunteers also recruit mentors, support jobseekers, build homes and provide other services for veterans and military families, and help citizens improve their financial literary skills. Our nation's leaders including congressional members, governors, and mayors honor Dr. King's legacy through service projects while addressing pressing community needs. Congress designated the holiday as a National Day of Service. Taking place each third Monday in January, the Martin Luther King, Jr. Day of service is the only federal holiday observed as a National Day of Service – a "day on, not a day off." This day of service helps to empower individuals, strengthen communities, bridge barriers, address social problems, and move us closer to Dr. King's vision of a "Beloved Community." (About the MLK Day of "Everyone can be great because everybody Service – AmeriCorps.)

Rev. Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. was a vital figure of the modern era and a pivotal figure in the Civil Rights Movement. His lectures and dialogues stirred the concern and sparked the conscience of a generation. His charismatic leadership inspired men and women, young and old, in this nation and around the world. Following in the footsteps of his father, in February 1948, at the age of 19, Rev. Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. entered the Christian ministry and was ordained at Ebenezer Baptist Church in Atlanta.

In 1954, upon completion of graduate studies at Boston University, he accepted a call to serve at the Dexter Avenue Baptist church in Montgomery, Alabama. While there, he was an instrumental leader in the Montgomery Bus Boycott, made famous by the nonviolent resistance and arrest of Rosa Parks. He resigned this position in 1959 and moved back to Atlanta to di-

rect the activities of the Southern Christian Leadership Conference. From 1960 until his death in 1968, he served as co-pastor with his father at Ebenezer Baptist Church, Martin Luther King, Jr. was shot while standing on the balcony of the Lorraine Motel in Memphis, Tennessee and died on April


