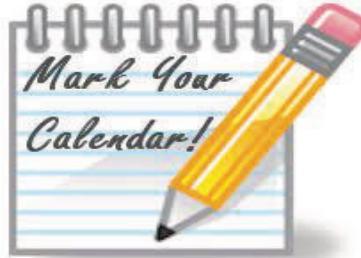

# TRAVEL & THEATRE

## TRIP POLICIES

Membership is required to participate in any travel. Members may bring a one time guest for an administrative fee of \$12 with a signed waiver. Members needing assistance must bring an escort and pay the guest administrative fee with a signed waiver along with the cost of the trip.

### PAYMENTS

If mailing a payment for a trip, PLEASE contact the center at 440-259-3772 before writing your check to ensure that it is made payable to the proper vendor.

Payment must be made in FULL for DAY trips when registering.

HALF payment must be made for MULTI-DAY trips when registering.

EXTENDED TRIPS require a \$75 deposit when registering. Additionally, we also require monthly payments (\$100 minimum) up until six weeks before trip departure or your reservation will be cancelled.

Some tour companies may have additional payment requirements that will supersede our requirements.

### CANCELLATIONS

If the Perry Senior Center cancels a trip, you will be notified and FULL refund will be made within ten business days.

Please call Christine or Beth Ann if you MUST absolutely cancel your reservation. We will work on options and make attempts to refund your money but we CANNOT guarantee that it will be possible.

You will NOT be issued a refund if you are not present the day of the trip unless given an authorized cancellation.
