

Divine Mercy Sunday

Ouestion:


Where did the feast of Divine Mercy come from?

Answer:

If you were born well before the year 2000, you know the feast of Divine Mercy has not always been celebrated in the Church. In the early 1900s, a young Polish nun began receiving private revelations. Jesus appeared to her during her times of prayer, speaking a message of mercy and love for the world. She received a set of prayers — the Divine Mercy Chaplet — and the request to have a feast day established to remind the Church of the mercy of God. St. Faustina died in 1938, on the cusp of war and in the midst of one of the most violent centuries in the history of the world.

Her story and her diaries began circulating in Poland and beyond. It quickly became apparent that this was a holy young women, and the cause for her canonization opened. In the year 2000, she was canonized by the first-ever Polish pope, St. John Paul II. On her canonization day, he established the second Sunday of Easter as Divine Mercy Sunday, "a perennial invitation to the Christian world to face, with confidence in divine benevolence, the difficulties and trials that mankind will experience in the years to come."

Notes from Sister Noel ...





This Monday the eighth graders of the parish will receive the sacrament of Confirmation. Their families join them in witnessing the Bishop anointing them with oil and speaking the words which makes them full members in the Church.

By taking a new name, it symbolizes a significant change in their faith journey. Just as at Baptism, the name given to them brings them into the Family of God, the Church. These young people have been prepared specifically for this sacrament. It calls them to take responsibility of their Call, just as their parents did for them at Baptism. Let us pray for them that their relationship with God will deepen. This is another reason to celebrate in this Easter season.

When you were confirmed the gifts of the Spirit were planted in you. How have you used the gifts to become your best self? Take a moment to thank God for each of them ... wisdom, understanding, counsel, knowledge, fortitude, piety and fear of the Lord (reverence). It is time to activate or reactivate them in your life. Don't know how to do it? Ask God to help you.

Think about which gift you need presently in your life. There you go, another reason to seek out God in your day. Just watch. Things will happen.


