"When I behold your heavens, the work of your fingers, the moon and the stars which you set in place -- What is man that you should be mindful of him, or the son of man that you should care for him?" (Ps. 8:4-5)

Over the past year, the parishes of the Diocese of Cleveland as well as the Diocese itself have been working together to find ways to help Catholic Schools thrive in our area. One of those discussions has transitioned into action with the creation of the "Angel Scholarship Fund". Here is how those working on the project describe it:

"New Ohio Scholarship Tax-Credit Program Lets You "Turn Taxes into Tuition" by Directing Your Tax Dollars to our Catholic School Students

Through the Angel Scholarship Fund, you can now contribute funds that will be used to provide tuition assistance for students to attend our Catholic schools, for which you may receive a 100% Ohio income tax credit of up to \$750 (\$1,500 if married filing jointly) against your 2022 state tax liability. In other words, the state of Ohio allows you to 'spend' some of the state income taxes you must pay anyway to provide tuition assistance for students seeking an education in our Catholic schools. The Angel Scholarship Fund is a win-win-win for taxpayer donors, scholarship recipients, and our Catholic schools."


