

From the Desk of Father Chris

"As they were proceeding on their journey someone said to him, 'I will follow you wherever you go.' Jesus answered him, 'Foxes have dens and birds of the sky have nests, but the Son of Man has nowhere to rest his head.'" (Lk 9:57-58)

This is the first Sunday since February that I've worn the color green. We journeyed together through the seasons of Lent and Easter. We also celebrated several solemnities on these past few Sundays. What does green signify in the Church? It represents Ordinary Time. A time for us to focus on our calling to follow Jesus. This weekend's readings focus on that very point. Consider how you say "yes" to Jesus this week. Do you live your "yes" through the way you serve your family, community, or those you don't know? Do you live your "yes" through serving God in volunteering for the Church? Or perhaps when Jesus says to you "come and follow me", your "yes" is similar to the many disciples who supported Jesus's ministry through their skills and finances? What does your "yes" look like?

Speaking of "yes" I've had a number of you over the past few months ask me when I might be getting away for a few days. Its been a long road since arriving on October 1st and that road has contained so many blessings. The biggest blessing to me has been all of you. I absolutely appreciate you all looking out for me. I'm happy to say that this week Wednesday through the following Friday that I'll be out of town (that's the end of June through July 8th). You'll have a guest priest coming in to celebrate the Sacraments, especially the Sacrament of Eucharist. I'm happy to say that Fr. Tom Sweany, our Pastor Emeritus, will be with you while I'm away. He said that he may even come to the 4th of July Parade!

Know that you'll all be kept in prayer while I'm away.




