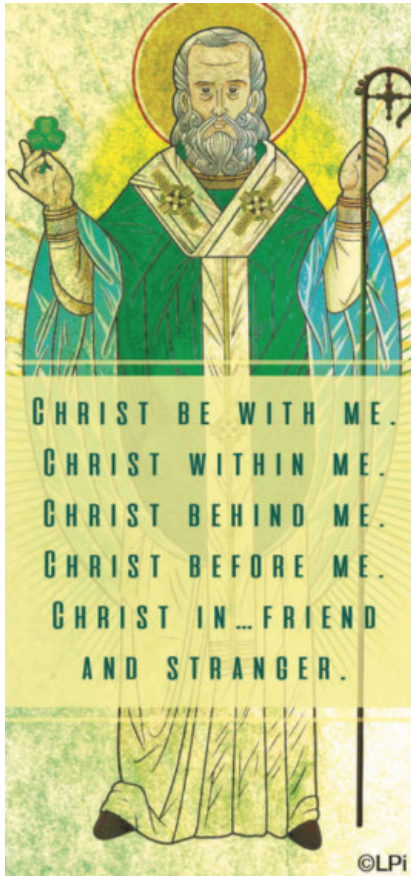

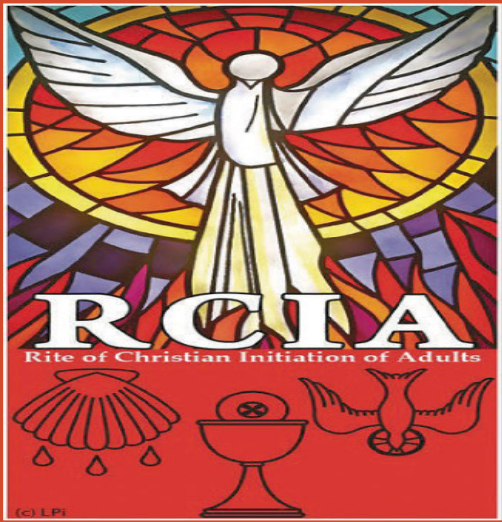

The new boiler is here and crews from Johnson's Boiler are hard at work installing the pieces. Heat should be restored to the Church within a week or two.



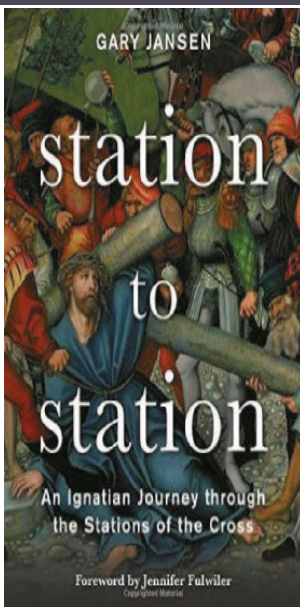
In the meantime, we have Panhandle Restoration providing warmth for this weekend's Masses.


