



Synodality: God forming us as we journey together by David Post and Louis Volpe

We began the synodality journey in November and continued through May. Over two-hundred St. Michael parishioners—young and old, teachers and students, women and men of all ages—came together to encounter each other and our church through ten different listening sessions. Our ultimate goal was to provide an opportunity for all of



our parishioners to gather together to listen, discuss, and discern on how best to move forward on the path of becoming a more synodal church. We came together in hope, after the isolations influenced by the Covid epidemic, by the past disasters of our diocese, and by our own self-induced anxieties and divisions.

What were the outcomes of our gatherings? Did we produce anything significant? Are we going to do anything? Are those the right questions to ask? Or, better than trying to copy much of society where we strive to calculate and quantify immediate production and success, should we ask: how did our synodal way of proceeding "elevate our faith in God and in each other?" Did our meeting and greeting each other build up our trust in each other as a people and as a parish? Did we gain an increased sense that we are not simply individuals who believe and practice our religion but a delightful awareness that God is building us together as a people traveling in faith?

For our part, we think that behind Pope Francis' prayerful intuition of introducing Catholics around the world to synodality was the hope for unity in a seemingly divided world—that our coming together, looking each other in the face, talking about our fears, hopes and dreams for our church and the Father's created world would be a renewed trust and confidence that God is truly forming us as we journey together. Contrary to the present-day appearances that people exist solely for themselves and consequently experience an aggravating sense of loneliness, this very relational approach of coming together as "church" and being present to each other both physically and prayerfully would lessen the cynical aloneness we often experience and lead us to a greater compassion for others. Indeed, it would deepen our worship at the Eucharistic liturgy, and most of all, fill us with a profound sense that Christ's words, "that all may be One," are being realized in this time and place by our efforts to journey together in unity—in other words, becoming truly "catholic."

We both enjoyed facilitating this first part of the synodal way. We delighted in seeing people come and dialogue with each other, seeking to express the ways that the Holy Spirit was speaking to them and receiving each other through dedicated listening. We offer a big "thank-you" to all those parishioners who participated and all those volunteers who helped with the Synod listening sessions. We know this is only the beginning of how the Father wants to form us; we are just beginning the synodal way. However, taking the time to see Christ Jesus in others has been life-affirming and forward-looking. Perhaps, after all, this was what Pope Francis had hoped we would discover: that by coming together, speaking to and hearing each other, and with the conviction that Christ is in us and for us, gradually discern our way forward in love and trust.

We hope that you, the parishioners of St. Michael Parish and our companions on the journey, will prayerfully read the six -page summary of the key ideas from our listening sessions that we presented to the Diocese of Wheeling/Charleston. Feel free to continue the dialogue and respond to us either by phone or e-mail. (And if you are really a glutton for punishment, get on the parish website and read the whole thirty-page report!)

For the present, with all the divisions caused by poverty, war, and denials of life, what more could we ask from each other and from the God of Love?


