



If you take the opportunity to read the St. Michael Parish Synod Listening Sessions Final Synthesis (which is available on our parish website), you'll see the following statement:


There is a greater need/demand from St. Michael's parishioners—older and younger—for small group interaction: faith and bible study groups, community action projects, social events which bring people together, etc.
