

Did you know? The altar at St. Mike's was consecrated on March 24, 1953 by Co-Adjutor Bishop Thomas McDonnell. Within the altar are the relics of St. Benedict, martyr, and St. Victoria, virgin, and martyr. St. Benedict the martyr is not the more famous St. Benedict of Nursia, founder of the Benedictine Order, but an Italian missionary who was murdered in what is now known as the Czech Republic along with four companions in the year 1005. His feast day is November 12th. St. Victoria, virgin and martyr, was born in Tivoli, Italy in the early 3rd Century and was murdered, as was her friend St. Anatolia in the year 253. Her feast day is December 23rd.


