

COMMEMORATIVE MASS ASSOCIATION is a means for parishioners and friends to remember their loved ones in a special way. Throughout the year of enrollment, a **total of 18 Masses** will be celebrated for the repose of the souls of those inscribed in the Association. The 18 Masses will be said on the First Friday of each month as well as Easter Sunday, Mother's Day, Father's Day, Feast of the Assumption, All Souls Day and Christmas Day. The bulletin will list all the names enrolled in the Parish Commemorative Mass Association for each occasion. The cost to enroll the deceased is \$50. This can be done at any time during the year. You may wish to inscribe members collectively as well (such as the Smith Family), for the same price. At the time of enrollment, you will receive a beautiful leatherette-type folder describing the benefits of the Association with a listing of the Masses to be celebrated. As the year of enrollment ends, you will be contacted to see if you want to renew your membership for the same annual enrollment cost of \$50. Offerings given for the Parish Commemorative Mass Association stay in our parish and are used for the liturgical needs. 




