


FROM THE ADMINISTRATOR'S DESK

GETTING EVEN

Ten years ago, almost to the day, I was driving home to Butler from a late-night meeting at the Seminary. I had to stop in a line of traffic waiting for a vehicle ahead to make a left turn. All of a sudden, I heard a loud bang, felt my car surge forward, and experienced a pain go down my spine. In a millisecond, I realized that I had just been rear-ended but that I also needed to stomp on my brakes to avoid hitting the person in front of me. Once I gathered my thoughts, I pulled off to the side of the road, jumped out of my car, and approached the vehicle behind me. There was a young girl in the driver's seat. She locked the doors and just stared down at her phone. I think she thought I was going to tear the doors off her car out of vengeance, even though I was in my priestly attire. Nonetheless, I just asked her, "Are you OK?" My car was only two years old. I had just spent a considerable amount of money on new tires. Shortly after this, I started to have back pains. Sure, I was upset. However, was it worth carrying the weight of anger around for the rest of my life? Sure, her insurance bought me a new car, but it didn't cover a piece of my life that had been lost. However, she was just a kid, who seems to have made a dumb mistake.

This weekend, our Scripture readings challenge us to take the high road. David is being pursued by his father-in-law, Saul, because Saul is jealous of David's popularity and prowess in battle. One night, David has the chance to kill Saul and have this dispute over and done with. Nonetheless, David spares Saul because David recognizes the importance of doing no harm to one anointed by God. In Luke's Gospel, Jesus exhorts, "Be merciful, just as your Father is merciful." (Lk 6:36) If we are abundant in our compassion toward others, so the Father will be toward us. Paul reminds us today that as mere mortals, "earthly", we are subject to our passions and emotions. However, as baptized into Christ Jesus, we are "heavenly" and so can and must act like the Man from Heaven.

"Getting even" generally means taking revenge for a supposed wrong, which is nothing about making things equal or even but about pointing out that someone is bigger and better than someone else.

Why can't WE "get even" by recognizing that WE are "made even" in the sight of God. The fullness of God's love rains down on all of US. WE may be different from an "earthly" perspective but not from a "heavenly" one. WE are gradually coming together as three communities with different sizes, perspectives, and resources into one. WE evenly share who WE are and what WE have. Through Baptism, WE are anointed by the Lord, and so no harm is to be done to US. Through Baptism, WE are made "heavenly" in union with Christ, and so WE are to work at raising each other from OUR "earthly" status. "Getting even" means appreciating that WE are all gifts to OURselves from God and are expected to be gifts to one another in God. Becoming one new parish means accepting that WE are all on a level playing field, and the leveling agent is God's love for all of US. Let's do OUR best to "get even".






**COME PRAY WITH US -- FROM HOME!

Is it often too tough to be up and about before that first cup-O-Joe? Well, bring your steeping hot mug and come join us from the comfort of your home - on ZOOM - for morning prayers, as we come together for the rosary, daily petitions, the daily Mass readings and a brief reflection. This regional on-line prayer group started to meet at the beginning of the COVID shut down back in March of 2020 with a group of faithful Catholics, including Deacon Jeff, in response to the need for a spiritual experience in those isolating days, but now continues to welcome participants from many neighboring North suburb parishes as well as friends and family members from all over the country. We start each morning promptly at 7:00 am, and finish by about 7:40 am. Feel like you might want to join but don't want to have to get all gussied up that early in the morning? No problem, leave your video feed off! - we won't mind. 




100th ANNIVERSARY OF THE SISTERS OF ST. FRANCIS OF THE PROVIDENCE OF GOD

St. Polycarp of Smyrna | February 23

As a disciple of St. John, the Evangelist, St. Polycarp was able to hear about Jesus' life, death, and resurrection directly from those who witnessed it. Because Polycarp was ordained as Bishop of Smyrna by St. John, he is one of three chief Apostolic Fathers, along with Clement of Rome and Ignatius of Antioch. During his life Polycarp defended the Church against heresies. His important writing, the Letter to the Philippians, quoted the Gospels and Acts of the Apostles, stressing Paul's authority in the Church and setting out clear arguments against the gnostic heresy that denied Christ's divinity.

The early period of the Church was a dangerous time to be a Christian and like many, St. Polycarp was martyred. He was captured by Romans and sentenced to burn at the stake. However, the fire did not touch him, instead rising up like sails around him. Seeing that the flames would not injure Polycarp, the Romans stabbed him instead. The Martyrdom of Polycarp is perhaps the earliest fully preserved account of a Christian martyr.

WHAT IS MAMMON?

Question:

When Jesus says, “You cannot serve both God and mammon,” what does he mean? What is mammon?

Answer:

When you hear Scripture proclaimed each Sunday, remember it wasn't originally written in English. Hebrew, Aramaic, Greek — these ancient tongues were the original language of our Old and New Testaments. Most of the time, all of the words are translated into our native language. Sometimes, a word or two is left in the original language. Such is the case in this Scripture passage.

Mammon is an ancient Aramaic word referring to money, wealth, or profit. Earthly wealth isn't bad in itself, nor does it automatically exclude us from being a disciple of Jesus. But what dominates our life? To serve money — that is, to seek accumulation of wealth for its own sake and to structure our lives around it — is morally problematic. What good is our wealth if it isn't at the service of others? What good is our wealth if its pursuit leads us to selfishness, obsession, greed, envy, and comparison? There are many things that can be opposed to our service of God — power, prestige, popularity. Ultimately, something in our lives will be our master. But there is only one God worth serving.


