


FROM THE ADMINISTATOR'S DESK

WHO WHOULD'VE THOUGHT?

Over the years, I've lived in a number of places around the country in business and a number of places around the Diocese as a priest. Some I was assigned to, and some I sought. Some I entered with excitement, and others I accepted with apprehension. However, in all of them, I have experienced the memorable hand of God. When things were successful, I understood the need to be thankful to God. When things took a downturn, I recognized that I needed to, and could, trust in God. Accomplishments weren't mine, but God's. Solutions and resolutions weren't mine, but God's. Sure, I have always tried to give it my best effort, but through the good times and through the bad times I have come to see that I've been watched over and taken care of. In my younger years, it was easy to think that so much of it was about me, but in my older years, it has become more and more obvious that I am not in the driver's seat - God is. Who would've thought?

This weekend, from the Book of Deuteronomy, Moses reminds the Israelites that when they finally arrive in the Promised Land they are to give thanks to God for saving them from the years of slavery in Egypt and the 40 years of wandering in the desert. They could have never accomplished this spectacular feat on their own. It was only due to the watchful eye and loving hand of God. To think otherwise would be foolish presumption. In Luke's Gospel, when Satan tries to tempt Jesus in the desert, Jesus sees through the ploy. Satan wants to be recognized as powerful and in charge, but Jesus knows the Father's love personally and will look nowhere else to find it. St. Paul reminds the Romans that no one can be saved on their own, but that all can be saved if we confess on our lips that Jesus is Lord and believe in our hearts that the Father has raised Him from the dead. We cannot accomplish this, but how amazing that it is offered to us so freely. Who would've thought?

WE find OURselves in the midst of a rather unique situation. WE are entering into the most difficult part of OUR merger. The time for talk is winding down, and the time for firm and decisive action is upon US. However, I hope WE haven't forgotten that all of this is a time for prayer. If WE look at this as something imposed upon US organizationally, it's far too easy to grumble. But if WE are willing to see that this is a moment of growth that God is challenging US to surrender OUR will to a goal that, perhaps, only He can foresee, if WE are willing to see that God's plan is not just for any one individual or any one

parish but for all of US, if WE are willing to see that God uses a number of people along the way to guide US and accompany US, if WE are willing to hold fast to the truth that Jesus is Lord and that the Father has raised Him from the dead, then WE will be saved and in the process become the parish that God has envisioned all along. Who would've thought? God...that's Who! And WE need to thank Him for it.

My hope is that people came away with a broader understanding of the scope of the undertaking and what has been done and still needs to be done to fashion our new parish. Let us use this Lenten Season of fast and prayer to open our hearts and minds to God's will for us.






