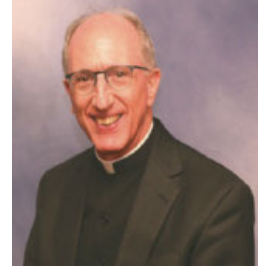
FROM THE ADMINISTRATOR'S DESK

HEROS

We all have heroes. Maybe they're sports heroes; maybe they're music heroes; maybe they're military heroes; maybe they're political heroes; maybe they're community heroes;...I think you get the idea. These are individuals who excel in their particular fields, individuals whom we admire, and perhaps individuals whom we emulate. Sometimes, they are even referred to in their own right as "gods". They seem to set the standard in their area of expertise, and everyone else is measured accordingly. While we may never be as proficient as our heroes, we keep trying because the greatest failure is not in being as good but in not even putting out the effort. Our admiration for a hero should inspire us on to heroic activity.

From the Book of Exodus this weekend, God appears to Moses in the burning bush on Mount Horeb. This, in and of itself, is pretty powerful, but then God says He cares – He cares about the suffering endured by the people of Israel and wants to relieve it. Yet, God goes even one step further. In identifying Himself, God reveals that He is the fullness of being, of existence, which means that all life has its roots in care and compassion – aka God. What a hero! What a standard for us to live up to! In the Gospel of Luke, Jesus warns against a failure to expend the effort to live up to this standard. While Jesus uses the word "perish", He does not indicate that He, as a hero, would destroy our life. Instead, He also uses the word "repent" to indicate that it is our responsibility to be heroes too by living up to the true meaning of life. St. Paul, in writing to the Corinthians, reminds us that God is a standard for life not merely from afar but by exercising true heroism in being present to us as a companion along the journey of life. Yes, sometimes that journey is hard and difficult, but we stall by thinking only of ourselves and failing to live with the trust in God and the care for others which exemplify a true hero.

As WE make OUR way toward the merger of OUR three parishes, WE can have no higher standard than God Himself – the great Three in One and One in Three. The One God unites the Three Persons, and the Three Persons seamlessly merge into One God, living the life of care and compassion. OUR three parishes coming together will have a fuller life as WE strengthen and encourage each other, as WE build with and upon each other. WE have the opportunity to emulate and witness to God Himself in living the true meaning of life together. WE can be heroes to one another and to others in the community, not out of any sense of vanity or false pride, but as examples of faith in a challenging reality and witnesses to the presence of OUR God alive in OUR very

midst, OUR God Who is the compassion and hope of daily life. OUR hero can make US heroes as well.

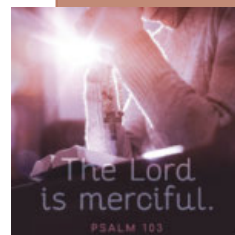

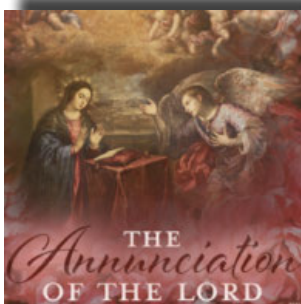

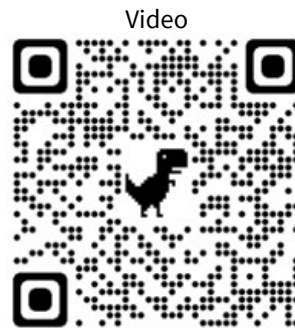

5th RD SUNDAY OF LENT



LENTEN REGULATIONS

1. **Ash Wednesday** and **Good Friday** are days of fast and abstinence. The **Fridays of Lent** are days of abstinence in the United States.
2. The obligation of abstinence (refraining from eating meat) begins at the age of 14. The law of fasting (limiting oneself to one full meal and two lighter meals) obliges all between the ages of 18-59. No one should consider this obligation lightly.
3. Those individuals who have a medical condition in which fasting may be considered harmful are not obliged to fast, but should perform some other act of penance or charity.
4. Pastors and parents are to see to it that minors, though not bound by the law of fast and abstinence, are educated in the authentic sense of penance and encouraged to do acts of penance suitable to their age.
5. Notable during this Lenten season is that the Solemnity of the Annunciation falls on a Friday. Because of this, **there is not an obligation to abstain from meat on Friday, March 25, 2022**, the Solemnity of the Annunciation, according to the norm of canon 1251.
6. All members of the Christian Faithful are encouraged to do acts of penance and charity during the Lenten season beyond what is prescribed by the law.
7. As a general rule, a request for a dispensation from the obligation of abstinence on Fridays of Lent will not be considered unless some serious reason is present. The attendance at social events, banquets, wedding rehearsals or receptions, or funeral wakes are not considered sufficient reason to request a dispensation.

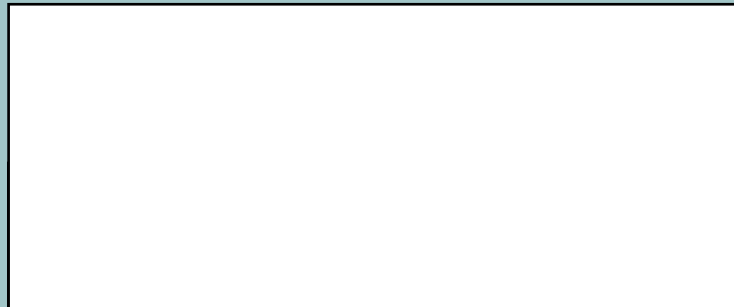

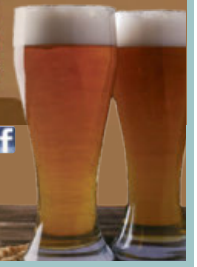
