

### From Our Administrator

#### FROM THE ADMINISTATOR'S DESK



#### NO ONE IS WELCOME

Outside of many businesses and many homes, you might see a sign or banner that reads, "Welcome". It might sound very warm and inviting. The people inside might be very cheerful and courteous. However, we all know that sooner or later we will bid our farewells and be ushered out. The reason for this is because this place isn't ours. It does not belong to us. It belongs to someone else. We do not belong there. "Welcome" means I go somewhere that's not my home, wait for someone else to let me in, act according to the house rules, and then leave when my purpose is complete. "Belonging", on the other hand, means this is my home; I have my own key and come and go as I please; I know the house rules because I made them up; this is the place where I stay rather than the place that I visit. How would we rather feel, like we are "welcome" or like we "belong"?

This weekend, from the Book of Joshua, we hear how the people of Israel crossed over into the Promised Land, and on the day following their first Passover celebration, they ate of the produce of the land. No longer did they have to rely on God to provide them with miraculous food. Now they could eat from the produce of their own gardens. They were finally home...they belonged. From Luke's Gospel, the parable of the Prodigal Son shows another homecoming. After the younger son squanders all of his inheritance, he returns to his father's house begging to be treated as a slave. He just wants to be welcomed into his father's employment, but his father will have none of it. The father dresses him in his former clothes and feeds him sumptuously because the son has come home; he belongs there. St. Paul reminds us that because of our union with Christ, we are "a new creation". (2 Cor 5:17) Because of our sinfulness, we have been separated from God and from each other; we did not belong together. However, with the saving work of Christ, we are now reconciled with God and with each other. It's Christ Who makes us belong and Who gives us the responsibility of making sure everyone feels like they belong; St. Paul calls it the "ministry of reconciliation". (2 Cor 5:18) No one is shut out, and everyone is brought home.

This week, I will be submitting to Bishop Zubik the petitions to merge OUR three parishes into one new parish. Part of those petitions is documentation elaborating how OUR parishes have worked together and collaborated to establish one new home for all of US. A closer inspection of the materials will show how WE began as three distinct parishes challenged to form a new unity. Over the years, WE have talked about it and put OUR talk into action.

Granted, WE have OUR differences, and sometimes the progress has been slow, but WE also know not only what WE're expected to become but also what WE are made to be – a microcosm of the one Body of Christ. WE may not be there yet, but WE're on the way home. While respecting differences, WE try to make sure that none of US feels welcome because all of US belongs. My hope is that on the inaugural day and beyond no one will welcome any of US to "their" church, but, like the father of the Prodigal Son, those greeting US at the doors will remind us that WE are all family, that WE've come home, and that WE belong. There will be no need for "Welcome" signs, because the only sign WE need will be open arms.

#### God Bless The Cities of God!

PS. In trying to craft a skilled and qualified staff and team for our new parish, serious concern and discernment were given to the faith education and enrichment of our parishioners. WE were very proud and delighted when we were able to bring on board Dr. Thom Brozich as our Director of Faith Formation. The next important piece of this department was to address the ministry to our youth and young adults. After a number of months of searching and interviewing, we are excited to announce that we have hired Justin D'Antonio as our new Youth and Young Adult Minister. He will report directly to Dr. Brozich as part of a seamless program across our entire Grouping. With a degree in education, he comes to us with strong leadership and organizational skills. Being a young adult himself with proven faith underpinnings, he will be able to offer solid peer ministry. We look forward to a revitalization of this important component of faith formation across our entire Grouping and eventual parish under Justin's guidance.

#### LENTEN REGULATIONS

- 1. <u>Ash Wednesday</u> and <u>Good Friday</u> are days of fast and abstinence. The <u>Fridays of Lent</u> are days of abstinence in the United States.
- 2. The obligation of abstinence (refraining from eating meat) begins at the age of 14. The law of fasting (limiting oneself to one full meal and two lighter meals) obliges all between the ages of 18-59. No one should consider this obligation lightly.
- 3. Those individuals who have a medical condition in which fasting may be considered harmful are not obliged to fast, but should perform some other act of penance or charity.
- 4. Pastors and parents are to see to it that minors, though not bound by the law of fast and abstinence, are educated in the authentic sense of penance and encouraged to do acts of penance suitable to their age.
- 5.Notable during this Lenten season is that the Solemnity of the Annunciation falls on a Friday. Because of this, there is not an obligation to abstain from meat on Friday, March 25, 2022, the Solemnity of the Annunciation, according to the norm of canon 1251.
- 6. All members of the Christian Faithful are encouraged to do acts of penance and charity during the Lenten season beyond what is prescribed by the law.
- 7. As a general rule, a request for a dispensation from the obligation of abstinence on Fridays of Lent will not be considered unless some serious reason is present. The attendance at social events, banquets, wedding rehearsals or receptions, or funeral wakes are not considered sufficient reason to request a dispensation.

There were papers spilled and chairs toppled but he gave everyone Chocolate Coins!








