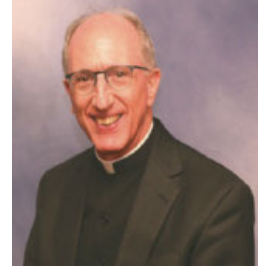
FROM THE ADMINISTRATOR'S DESK

MOVING FORWARD

There's a reason why our cars, trucks, and SUV's have multiple forward gears and generally only one gear for reverse - we are meant to spend the majority of our time driving forward and at a higher rate of speed than driving backwards. We have eyes on the front of our heads and not on the back (except for moms) since they face the direction that we generally move. The future is filled with hopes that we plan and anticipate, but the past is filled with remembrances and regrets that we rehash. Creativity is about the new; comfort is about the old. We grow up to experience more, but we never grow down to experience less. Faith is a personal relationship with God that is meant to mature, not wither. Heaven, not earth, is our goal. We are made for forward progress - mentally, spiritually, physically, socially, etc.

Through the prophet Isaiah, this weekend we hear the Lord telling His people not to get so bogged down with things of the past but to focus on what He has in store for them: "Remember not the events of the past, the things of long ago consider not; see, I am doing something new!" (Is 43:18-19) Jesus from the Gospel of John tells the woman caught in adultery that He has forgiven the sin of her past and that she is to move on from this into the future. St. Paul, in writing to the Philippians, proclaims that he considers all the things of his past to be "rubbish" (Phil 3:8) in the maturity and hope that he might possess the resurrection of the dead because Christ has taken possession of him. (Phil 3:12) His primary concern is to live for what God holds in store for him - "Just one thing: forgetting what lies behind but straining forward to what lies ahead, I continue my pursuit toward the goal, the prize of God's upward calling, in Christ Jesus." (Phil 3:13-14)

WE have done OUR due diligence, and now OUR future lies in the all-loving hands of the Holy Spirit. This past week, I submitted to Bishop Zubik OUR formal petition to merge OUR three parishes into one. After these 3 ½ years of prayer, discernment, consultation, and collaboration, WE are ready for where and how God wants to lead US into the future of OUR faith together. WE will no longer be the parishes of St. Ferdinand, St. Gregory, and Holy Redeemer (though OUR churches

will retain these names). Instead, WE will be a new parish named hopefully after one of the five most popularly recommended (in order of voters' choice):

1. Divine Grace
2. Merciful Heart of Jesus
3. Divine Healer
4. Holy Magi
5. St. Gianna

OUR prayer is that God will guide the heart and selection of Bishop Zubik to enable US and to empower US for a future that will form US more deeply into the one Body of Christ. While WE bring what WE have, WE are what WE will become. The time has come for US not just to move on "from" but to move forward "to". WE move forward to a more perfect fulfillment of the great mandate of Jesus Christ by loving God and loving OUR neighbor.

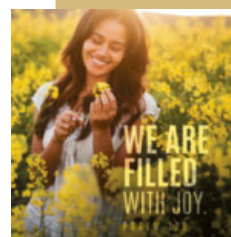

LENTEN REGULATIONS

1. **Ash Wednesday** and **Good Friday** are days of fast and abstinence. The **Fridays of Lent** are days of abstinence in the United States.
2. The obligation of abstinence (refraining from eating meat) begins at the age of 14. The law of fasting (limiting oneself to one full meal and two lighter meals) obliges all between the ages of 18-59. No one should consider this obligation lightly.
3. Those individuals who have a medical condition in which fasting may be considered harmful are not obliged to fast, but should perform some other act of penance or charity.
4. Pastors and parents are to see to it that minors, though not bound by the law of fast and abstinence, are educated in the authentic sense of penance and encouraged to do acts of penance suitable to their age.
5. Notable during this Lenten season is that the Solemnity of the Annunciation falls on a Friday. Because of this, **there is not an obligation to abstain from meat on Friday, March 25, 2022**, the Solemnity of the Annunciation, according to the norm of canon 1251.
6. All members of the Christian Faithful are encouraged to do acts of penance and charity during the Lenten season beyond what is prescribed by the law.
7. As a general rule, a request for a dispensation from the obligation of abstinence on Fridays of Lent will not be considered unless some serious reason is present. The attendance at social events, banquets, wedding rehearsals or receptions, or funeral wakes are not considered sufficient reason to request a dispensation.

ATTENTION PARISHIONERS OF THE CITIES OF GOD

The Ladies of Charity from Holy Redeemer are holding a Divine Mercy prayer service on Divine Mercy Sunday, which is the first Sunday after Easter, April 24. The service will last approximately 30 minutes and begins at 2:45 pm in Holy Redeemer church.

Divine Mercy Sunday is our opportunity to receive total forgiveness of all your sins AND punishment.

Requirements are:

You must be free of all sin by going to confession up to 20 days before Divine Mercy Sunday and receive Communion on Divine Mercy Sunday (either on that Sunday or the vigil Mass of that Sunday)

You must also say a short prayer asking God for the grace promised through Divine Mercy Sunday and trust in God.

The Study of Mummification

Even though St. Patrick's Day was a few weeks ago we wanted to share some of the Leprechaun Traps that our 4-year old Preschoolers built.



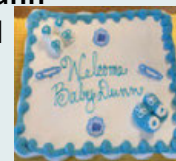
They were very inventive with their designs but that sneaky Leprechaun still managed to run free. Better luck next year!

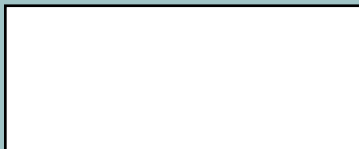

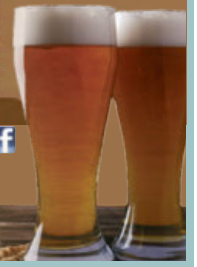
