FROM THE ADMINISTATOR'S DESK

A FRIEND ON THE INSIDE

Growing up, I think my older brother felt a sense of responsibility to look out for me, although he'd never admit it. He was two years ahead of me in school, and so when the time came for me to enter 1st Grade, he showed me around the school and introduced me to his friends. It felt like I had someone guiding and protecting me. Of course, if he thought I was doing something lame or worthless, he was the first to point it out, which made me unsure whether he was worried about me looking bad or about me making him look bad. Nonetheless, he made me think twice before I did something. He once saved my life at a community pool when he saw me struggling in deep water. He grabbed me and took me to the side of the pool, but then proceeded to holler at me for being where I shouldn't have been. Yet, how did he even notice me having trouble if he hadn't been watching out for me in the first place? He's the first person I can remember who supported me in my idea to be a priest - of course he thought it was great since he believed it to be a cushy job, but it has always meant a lot to me that he cared to even comment. His presence in the background or foreground has been influential to my path.

This weekend, the Lord reminds us that we are important to Him and that He cares about our every move. From John's Gospel, we hear Jesus calling us His sheep whom He knows personally and whom He and the Father lovingly hold in the palms of Their hands. We are safe and secure. From the Acts of the Apostles, we see how Paul and Barnabas, while being rejected by the Jewish community in Antioch, are confident in God's plan for them to approach the Jewish people first but in the midst of rejection can also see the hand of God leading them to minister to the Gentiles. From the Book of Revelation, John relates his vision of the early Christian martyrs victorious in heaven where "The Christ as Deacon Jeff explains, discusses, and answers one who sits on the throne will shelter them." (Rev. 7:15) In all cases, whatever the concern, the Lord watches out for His people with an all-knowing and allloving eye.

Getting to the merger has not always been easy for US, but God has always been with US and supported US. When WE've struggled, He's invited US to pray more. When WE've been uncertain, He's welcomed OUR trust. Zoom session by Thursday, June 2.

He knows exactly what WE need even if WE don't, and He will ultimately show US His appreciation by protecting and encouraging US. He's OUR friend on the inside who knows what needs to happen and will not let US fail. Why? Because He loves US...enough said!




