Reflection From The Pastor

4 | March 12, 2023

Third Sunday of Lent

In our first reading, The Hebrews thirst as they journey through the dessert to the Promised Land. Jesus encounters the Samaritan woman who has lived a life of sin. As she encounters the Lord, she recognizes her own thirst for truth. In this Lenten Season, we deepen our faith in the Holy Eucharist that Jesus instituted to feed our spiritual life. Do we turn only to worldly things to feed our lives? Is the Eucharist truly the bedrock and foundation of our spiritual lives? How can we find time to quench our hunger by reading the Sacred Scripture?

Faith Formation This Week

I will offer a presentation this Tuesday, March 14 at 6:30 pm at Saint Ferdinand in Oldenski Hall and again on Wednesday, March 15 at 6:30 pm at Holy Redeemer Church on the topic of priestly celibacy, marriage and priesthood, forming seminarians for life-long chaste celibacy, the psycho-sexual development of seminarians, issues that bar candidates from the priesthood, priest predators, and related themes. I served for 20 years in three seminaries in the U.S. as a Rector. I will share with the participants very practical points of how the Church prepares seminarians for the priesthood, screenings we use, and how we recommend to the Bishop candidates for ordination.

Moral Issues and Church Teaching

I will offer a presentation Tuesday, March 21 at 6:30 pm at Saint Ferdinand in Oldenski Hall and again on Wednesday, March 22 at 6:30 pm at Holy Redeemer Church on moral issues including homosexuality, just war theory, death penalty, and other moral issues that Catholics often struggle with or how non-Catholics have misunderstandings of what the Church teaches.


