## New Crucifix at Saint Ferdinand

We are hoping to suspend the resurrected corpus of Jesus in the narthex above the main doors as you exit the church.

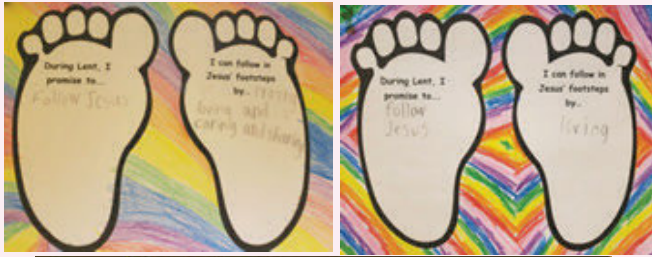

They are learning about taking small steps every day and thinking more about "What Would Jesus Do".

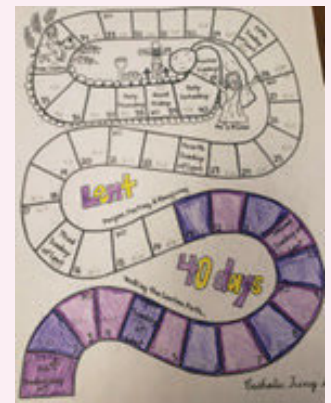
They colored beautiful stained glass crosses to remind us of the Lenten season.



Each of the Third Grade students colored their own Stations of the Cross. They are also following a 40-step Lenten Journey as Jesus walked.



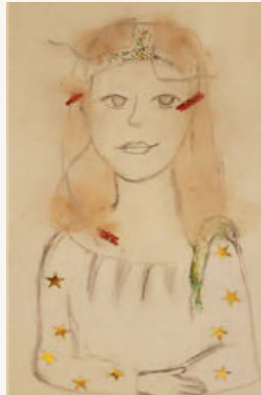
In addition, they have been working on a "40 Days with the Saints" packet where they read about a new saint, and do an activity followed by prayer.
