Passion/Palm Sunday

The palm was used in the Roman times of Jesus as a sign of victory by soldiers after battles. The battle of light over darkness, life over death, Jesus over Satan, represents the spiritual life of each Christian. When you take a palm home this weekend, display it publicly and humbly in your home behind the crucifix or a holy image as a reminder of how sin is conquered by the Divine Grace of Our Lord.

Anniversary of the Death of Saint John Paul II

This Sunday, April 2, marks the anniversary of the Holy Father's death in 2005. May he continue to intercede over the Universal Church.

The Solemn Days of Holy Week

These days mark the holiest week of the year as we enter into the Passion, Suffering, Death, and Resurrection of Jesus. Baptism has placed us into this Pascha, Mystery as well, therefore our commemoration of these days is not a mere remembrance of past events rather our own personal and communal participation into these events through the liturgies of the Church.

Holy Wednesday Evening Mass

In addition to the usual morning Masses, there will also be a 7:00 pm Mass at Saint Ferdinand this Wednesday.

The Chrism Mass

The clergy and laity of the diocese will gather on Holy Thursday for Mass at our Mother Church, Saint Paul Cathedral at 10:00 am in which priests renew their priestly promises and the holy oils of the Church are blessed by the Bishop for use in baptisms, anointing of the sick, and confirmations. I would encourage those who can to attend this beautiful liturgy.

Mass of the Lord's Supper

This Thursday at 7:00 pm, all three churches will celebrate the commemoration of Jesus' Institution of the Holy Eucharist and the Priesthood as well as the washing of feet that represents the diakonia of Our Lord. The Eucharist is the central mystery of our Catholic Faith.

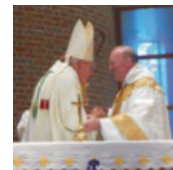
Good Friday Stations of the Cross and the Passion Liturgy

The Divine Mercy Chaplet

Our Lord announced to Saint Faustina the Divine Mercy Chaplet that uses the rosary beads for the prayers. Catholics are encouraged to pray the chaplet for 9 days from Good Friday through the Second Sunday of Easter which is now called Divine Mercy Sunday. The chaplet will be prayed at all three churches on Good Friday at 2:30 pm. The prayer card will be available for those who are new to this prayer.

Good Friday Tenebrae

We will celebrate this ancient prayer service at 7:00 p.m. at Holy Redeemer Church on Good Friday. If you have never experienced this prayer, it is quite impressive in its simplicity.

Good Friday Lenten Fish Lunches and Dinners

Take-out lunches from 11:30 am- 1:30 p.m. and dinners will be served from 3:00 pm-7:00 pm at Oldenski Hall at Saint Ferdinand.

The Paschal Fast

Please note that on Good Friday abstaining from meat begins at the age of 14 and the law of fasting with one full meal and two lighter meals obliges all between the ages of 18-59. Those with a medical condition are not obliged to fast but should perform another act of penance. The fast should, if possible, proceed until after the Easter Vigil.

Blessing of Easter Baskets

All three churches will bless Easter baskets at Noon on Holy Saturday. You can bring your Easter Dinner items and even the Easter baskets that children may be getting on Easter Sunday to be blessed by one of the clergy.

The Great Vigil of Easter

The most solemn liturgy of the year commemorates the greatest victory of God in salvation history – the Resurrection of Jesus Christ. New Catholics will be initiated into the Church at Saint Ferdinand with the Mass starting at 7:00 pm. Saint Gregory will celebrate Mass at 8:00 pm and Holy Redeemer at 8:30 pm.

Easter Sunday Masses

The schedule will be the same at all three churches except there is no 5:00 pm Sunday Mass at Saint Ferdinand. We welcome our many visitors and guests – please express a welcoming attitude and greet our guests so they feel welcomed.

Weekend Collections

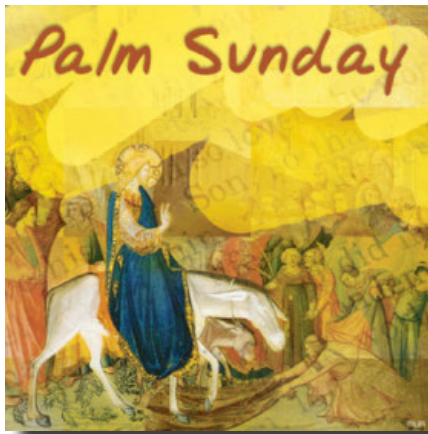
Because of your generosity, the total collection from the 12 weekend Masses on the weekend of March 18-19 was \$27,182. Please know that we do not take your generosity for granted.

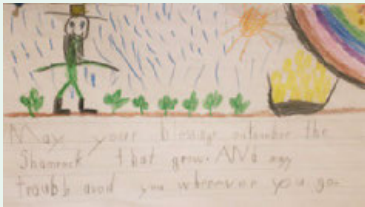


Do heaven and earth unite in the worship of God at Holy Mass?

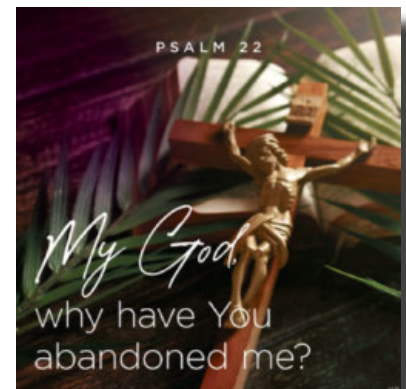

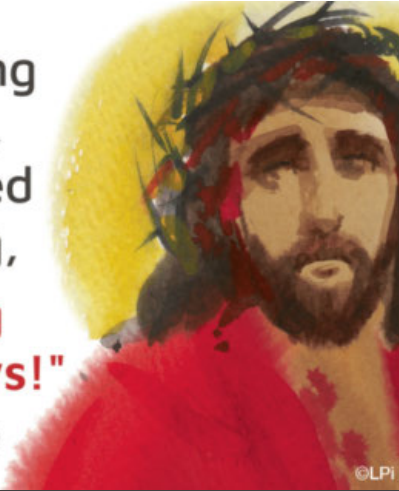

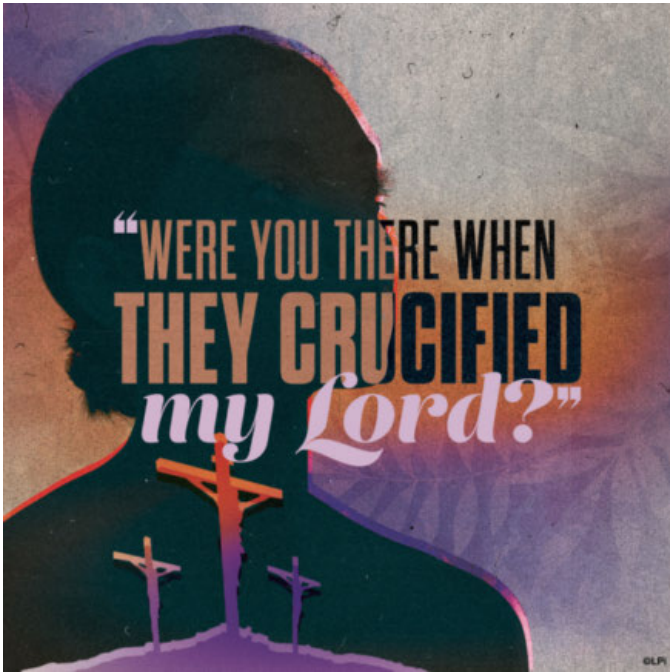
